    Acts 13:1 Now in the church that was at Antioch...

  - a. Believers Between Pentecost & the Rapture (Universal) (1 Thes 4:14-17)
  - b. Believers Assembled in a Committed Group (Local) (Phil 1:1)
- 4. What Is the Church's Relationship to Israel and the Gentiles?
