God's 3-Part Process of Disciple Making:

1. Conversion:

Involves My Belief in Jesus as My Savior

2. Commitment:

Involves My <u>Baptism</u> by which I Proclaim My Belief in the Savior & My Relationship & Responsibility to God's People

3. Conduct:

Involves My <u>Behavior</u> as I <u>Learn</u> & <u>Obey</u> Jesus Commands

Different Ways of Saying "Make Disciples":

¹⁵ And He said to them, "Go into all the world and preach the gospel to every creature. ¹⁶ "He who believes and is baptized will be saved; but he who does not believe will be condemned. (Mar 16:15-16)

⁴⁶ Then He said to them, "Thus it is written, and thus it was necessary for the Christ to suffer and to rise from the dead the third day, ⁴⁷ "and that repentance and remission of sins should be preached in His name to all nations, beginning at Jerusalem. (Luk 24:46-47)
