# Jesus Is the LIGHT (John 1:4b)

In Him was life, and the life was the light of men.

ἐν αὐτῷ ζωὴ ἦν, καὶ ἡ ζωὴ ἦν τὸ φῶς τῶν ἀνθρώπων·

### Jesus Is GOD (John 1:1-2)

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. The same was in the beginning with God.

- 1. The Existence of the Word WHEN He Was ("In the beginning was the Word")
- 2. The Presence of the Word WHERE He Was ("and the Word was with God")
- 3. The Essence of the Word WHAT He Was ("and the Word was God")
- 4. The Face of the Word WHO He Was John 1:14 ("the Word became flesh")

### Jesus Is the CREATOR of Everything (John 1:3)

All things were made through Him, and without Him nothing was made that was made.

- 1. The Fact of Jesus' "Creatorship" ("All things through Him became")
- 2. The Extent of Jesus' "Creatorship" (cp Col 1:15-17)
  - Without him became not one thing which has become.
  - Where (any *place*); What (any *thing*); Who (any *body*)
- 3. The Purpose of His "Creatorship" Worship (Rev 4:11); Service (Eph 2:10)
- 4. The Results of His "Creatorship" Accountability (Heb 4:13); Authority (Rom 8:39)

### Jesus Is LIFE (John 1:4a) – Introduction

In Him was life, and the life was the light of men.

- 1. Two Words for "Life"
  - βίος bios process of life experience
  - ζωή zōē presence of life existence
- 2. Two Realms of "Life"
  - Creation physical life (everyone)
  - New Creation spiritual life (only the saved)
- 3. The Opposite of "Life" Opposite of ζωή (zōē) is death
  - John 5:24 "Most assuredly, I say to you, he who hears My word and believes in Him who sent Me has everlasting life, and shall not come into judgment, but has passed from death into life." (cf. Gen 2:17; Eph 2:5)
- 4. The Full Meaning of "Life"
  - Sin results in DEATH
  - Life requires HOLINESS
- 5. The Provision of "Life" (John 3:16 eternal life; 10:10 abundant life)

## Jesus Is LIFE (John 1:4a) - Meaning

- 1. Jesus is the Originator or Author of Life (John 1:4; 5:26)
- 2. Jesus is the Restorer of Eternal Life
  - A. LIFE: The POSSESSION of Eternal Life (John 11:25; 14:6; 1 John 5:12)
  - B. LIVING: The FUNCTION of Eternal Life (2 Cor 4:10-12 life of Jesus manifested)
  - C. ENDING: The FULFILLMENT of Eternal Life
    Col 3:4 When Christ *who is* our life appears, then you also will appear with Him in glory.
