#### Jesus Is...: A Summary of John 1:1-18

### 1. Jesus Is GOD (John 1:1-2)

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. The same was in the beginning with God.

- 1. The Existence of the Word WHEN He Was ("In the beginning was the Word")
- 2. The Presence of the Word WHERE He Was ("and the Word was with God")
- 3. The Essence of the Word WHAT He Was ("and the Word was God")
- 4. The Face of the Word WHO He Was John 1:14 ("the Word became flesh")

## 2. Jesus Is the CREATOR of Everything (John 1:3)

All things were made through Him, and without Him nothing was made that was made.

- 1. The Fact of Jesus' "Creatorship" ("All things through Him became")
- 2. The Extent of Jesus' "Creatorship" (cp Col 1:15-17)
  - Without him became not one thing which has become.
  - Where (any *place*); What (any *thing*); Who (any *body*)
- 3. The Purpose of His "Creatorship" Worship (Rev 4:11); Service (Eph 2:10)
- 4. The Results of His "Creatorship" Accountability (Heb 4:13); Authority (Rom 8:39)

#### 3. Jesus Is LIFE (John 1:4a)

In Him was life, and the life was the light of men.

- 1. Jesus is the Originator or Author of Life (John 1:4; 5:26)
- 2. Jesus is the Restorer of Eternal Life
  - A. LIFE: The POSSESSION of Eternal Life (John 11:25; 14:6; 1 John 5:12)
  - B. LIVING: The FUNCTION of Eternal Life (2 Cor 4:10-12 life of Jesus manifested)
  - C. ENDING: The FULFILLMENT of Eternal Life (Col 3:4)
- 3. Who Is Jesus to You?

## 4. Jesus Is the LIGHT (John 1:4b)

#### 9 Observations

- 1. 1:5 Jesus' light overcomes darkness.
- 2. 1:5 Jesus' light <u>repels</u> darkness. *(ESV: "has not overcome it") ("repels" could mean "comprehend" or "grasp" or "to make one's own" too)*
- 3. 1:7 Jesus' light requires belief.
- 1:7 Jesus' light requires belief by all.
- 5. 1:8 Jesus' light requires witnessing.
- 6. 1:9 Jesus' light is the true light.
- 1:9 Jesus' light has its imposters.
- 8. 1:9 Jesus' light is available to all.
- 9. 1:10 Jesus' light is needed by all.

#### God Gives His Son (John 3:16-18)

- 1. God's ACTION What Did God Do? (16)
- 2. God's INTENTION Why Did God Do It? (17)
- 3. Our DECISION What Must I Do? (18) Two Categories of People

#### God's Light Reveals (John 3:19-21)

- 1. Condemnation Why Are People Under Judgment? (19a)
- 2. Rejection Because They Loved Darkness rather than the Light (19b)

### Jesus Is the LIGHT: What Happens (John 1:5)

- <sup>5</sup> And the light shines in the darkness, and the darkness did not comprehend it.
- 1. ACTIVE The light shines
- 2. EFFECTIVE In the darkness
- R. INVINCIBLE And the darkness did not comprehend it.

## Jesus Is the TRUE Light (1:9a)

- 1. Jesus Is the TRUE Light
- 2. There Must Be FALSE Lights
- 3. The Bible Gives Us Warnings!

Mat 7:15-16 Beware of false prophets, who come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ravenous wolves.... You will know them by their fruits. Do men gather grapes from thombushes or figs from thistles?

# Jesus Is the Rejected and Received Word (1:10-12)

## Jesus Is the Real, Experienced Word (John 1:14-16)

- 1. The Word Was Physically <u>Present</u> (14a)
- 2. The Word Was Divinely Pointed Out (14b)
- 3. The Word Was Verbally Proclaimed (15)
- 4. The Word Was Personally Experienced (16)

## Jesus Is the Creator of Grace and Truth (1:17)

#### MOSES & THE LAW: The Law Was Given Through Moses

- PICTURE: The Law Was an Introduction and Representation of What Was to Follow
- TEACHER: The Law Was a Tutor to Bring Us to Christ
- MEASURE: The Law Was a Revealer to Make Us Aware of Our Sin

#### JESUS & GRACE & TRUTH: Grace and Truth "Became" Through Jesus Christ

- The Savior: Jesus Came to Rescue Us from the Results of Sin and the Law
- The Solution: Jesus Fulfilled the Law So That We Could Be Saved by Grace
- The Standard: Grace Is the New Measure by Which We Live
- The Source: Jesus as God Is the Source of Truth for Saving and for Living

## Jesus Is the Explainer of the Unseen God (John 1:18)

- 1. No one has seen God [the Father]
- 2. Jesus is God Who Took on a Form that Could Interact with Man
- 3. Jesus is THE One Who:
  - a. knows God the Father
  - b. shares omniscience with God
  - c. came to accurately explain God in detail (John 3:16)
  - d. is "the way, truth, life" (John 14:6)
  - e. is the "One mediator" between God and man (1 Tim 2:5-6)
