What Is a Disciple?: 3 Goals of Following Jesus

What Is Discipleship? (more on this later)

Matt 11:29 Take My yoke upon you and **learn** from Me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls.

Matt 10:24-25 ²⁴ A disciple is not above *his* teacher, nor a servant above his master. ²⁵ It is enough for a disciple that he **be like his teacher**, and a servant like his master. ...If they have called the master of the house Beelzebub, how much more *will they call* those of his household! (cp 1 John 2:6)

1 Tim 4:6-7 ⁶ If you instruct the brethren in these things, you will be a good minister of Jesus Christ, nourished in the words of faith and of the good doctrine which you have carefully followed. ⁷ But reject profane and old wives' fables, and exercise yourself toward godliness.

1. A Disciple is a <u>Truth-Knower</u>

God wants me to learn and to live His Word.

John 8:30-36 ³⁰ As He spoke these words, many believed in Him. ³¹ Then Jesus said to those Jews who believed Him, "If you abide in My word, you are My disciples indeed. ³² And you shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free." ³³ They answered Him, "We are Abraham's descendants, and have never been in bondage to anyone. How *can* you say, 'You will be made free'?" ³⁴ Jesus answered them, "Most assuredly, I say to you, whoever commits sin is a slave of sin. ³⁵ And a slave does not abide in the house forever, *but* a son abides forever. ³⁶ Therefore if the Son makes you free, you shall be free indeed.

- □ Observations (30-31):
 - Belief is <u>not equal</u> to discipleship. (Eph 2:8-9)
 - Condition: "IF you abide in My Word..."
 - Effect: lit. "truly disciples of Me you are"
- □ Definition (31b):
 - Discipleship = <u>Abiding</u> in the <u>Word</u>.
- Results (32):
 - Result #1: Knowledge of the Truth!
 - Result #2: Freedom from Sin through the Truth!
- □ Focus: My relationship to God's Word.

2. A Disciple Is a Brother-Lover

② God wants me to <u>commit</u> to and <u>care</u> for believers.

John 13:34-35 34 A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another; as I have loved you, that you also love one another. 35 By this all will know that you are My disciples, if you have love for one another."

- Observations:
 - Command: Love One Another [Is this new? Lev 19:18]
 - Comparison: The measure of our love is... (v.34)
 - Condition: "IF you have love for one another."
 - Effect: "All will know that you are My disciples."
- □ Definition (35):
 - Discipleship = Loving Our Brethren
- □ Results:
 - Result #1: Internal → Unconditional Care
 - Result #2: External → Supernatural Evidence
- □ Focus: My Relationship to God' People

3. A Disciple Is a Fruit-Bearer

② God wants me to <u>pursue</u> and to <u>produce</u> godly conduct.

John 15:5-16 5 I am the vine, you are the branches. He who abides in Me, and I in him, bears much fruit; for without Me you can do nothing. 6 If anyone does not abide in Me, he is cast out as a branch and is withered; and they gather them and throw them into the fire, and they are burned. 7 If you abide in Me, and My words abide in you, you will ask what you desire, and it shall be done for you. 8 By this My Father is glorified, that you bear much fruit; so you will be My disciples. 9 "As the Father loved Me, I also have loved you; abide in My love. 10 If you keep My commandments, you will abide in My love, just as I have kept My Father's commandments and abide in His love. 11 These things I have spoken to you, that My joy may remain in you, and *that* your joy may be full. ¹² This is My commandment, that you love one another as I have loved you. 13 Greater love has no one than this, than to lay down one's life for his friends. ¹⁴ You are My friends if you do whatever I command you. ¹⁵ No longer do I call you servants, for a servant does not know what his master is doing; but I have called you friends, for all things that I heard from My Father I have made known to you. ¹⁶ You did not choose Me, but I chose you and appointed you that you should go and bear fruit, and that your fruit should remain, that whatever you ask the Father in My name He may give you.

- Observations:
 - We are to bear much fruit ("fruit" 8x in vv. 1-17!)
- □ Result: God Is Glorified (huh?)
- □ Definition (8):
 - Discipleship = Bearing Much Fruit
- □ Focus: My relationship to God's Plan.

What Is a Disciple? (3 Goals)

God wants me to be a Truth-Knower:

• One who lives in and by God's Word, letting the Word change my thinking, and give me victory over sin. Am I?

God wants me to be a Brother-Lover:

One who cares, sacrifices, and dies, if need be, for the benefit of my brethren. Am I?

God wants me to be a Fruit-Bearer:

 One who seeks, by attitude and action, to purpose and produce God-directed responses, activities, and works. Am I?
