פְּלִיטָה, פֶּלֶטָה: cs. פֶּלֶטָה: — 1. what has **escaped**, what is **spared** Ex 10₅ 2K 19_{30f}, hāyâ liflêṭâ be able to escape Gn 32₉; — 2. **escape, deliverance** Gn 45₇. (pg 292)

Gen 32:8 And he said, "If Esau comes to the one company and attacks it, then the other company which is left will **escape**."

Gen. 45:7 "And God sent me before you to preserve a posterity for you in the earth, and to save your lives by a great **deliverance**."

Ex 10:5 `And they shall cover the face of the earth, so that no one will be able to see the earth; and they shall eat the residue of what is **left**, which remains to you from the hail, and they shall eat every tree which grows up for you out of the field.

Jdg 21:17 And they said, "*There must be* an inheritance for the **survivors** of Benjamin, that a tribe may not be destroyed from Israel.

2 Sam 15:14 So David said to all his servants who *were* with him at Jerusalem, "Arise, and let us flee; or we shall not **escape** from Absalom. Make haste to depart, lest he overtake us suddenly and bring disaster upon us, and strike the city with the edge of the sword."

2 Ki 19:30 And the remnant who have **escaped** of the house of Judah Shall again take root downward, And bear fruit upward.

2 Ki 19:31 For out of Jerusalem shall go a remnant, And those who **escape** from Mount Zion. The zeal of the LORD of hosts will do this.'

1 Chr 4:43 And they defeated the rest of the Amalekites who had **escaped**. They have dwelt there to this day.

2 Chr 12:7 Now when the LORD saw that they humbled themselves, the word of the LORD came to Shemaiah, saying, "They have humbled themselves; *therefore* I will not destroy them, but I will grant them some **deliverance**. My wrath shall not be poured out on Jerusalem by the hand of Shishak.

2 Chr 20:24 So when Judah came to a place overlooking the wilderness, they looked toward the multitude; and there *were* their dead bodies, fallen on the earth. No one had **escaped**.

2 Chr 30:6 Then the runners went throughout all Israel and Judah with the letters from the king and his leaders, and spoke according to the command of the king: "Children of Israel, return to the LORD God of Abraham, Isaac, and Israel; then He will return to the remnant of you who have **escaped** from the hand of the kings of Assyria.

Ezr 9:8 "And now for a little while grace has been *shown* from the LORD our God, to leave us a remnant to **escape**, and to give us a peg in His holy place, that our God may enlighten our eyes and give us a measure of revival in our bondage.

Ezr 9:13 "And after all that has come upon us for our evil deeds and for our great guilt, since You our God have punished us less than our iniquities *deserve*, and have given us **such deliverance** as this,

Ezr 9:14 "should we again break Your commandments, and join in marriage with the people *committing* these abominations? Would You not be angry with us until You had consumed *us*, so that *there would be* no remnant or *survivor*?"

Ezr 9:15 "O LORD God of Israel, You *are* righteous, for we are left as a *remnant*, as *it is* this day. Here we *are* before You, in our guilt, though no one can stand before You because of this!"

Neh 1:2 that Hanani one of my brethren came with men from Judah; and I asked them concerning the Jews who had *escaped*, who had survived the captivity, and concerning Jerusalem.

Isa 4:2 In that day the Branch of the LORD shall be beautiful and glorious; And the fruit of the earth *shall be* excellent and appealing For those of Israel who have *escaped*.

Isa 10:20 And it shall come to pass in that day *That* the remnant of Israel, And such as have *escaped* of the house of Jacob, Will never again depend on him who defeated them, But will depend on the LORD, the Holy One of Israel, in truth.

Isa 15:9 For the waters of Dimon will be full of blood; Because I will bring more upon Dimon, Lions upon him who *escapes* from Moab, And on the remnant of the land."

Isa 37:31 And the remnant who have *escaped* of the house of Judah Shall again take root downward, And bear fruit upward.

Isa 37:32 For out of Jerusalem shall go a remnant, And those who *escape* from Mount Zion. The zeal of the LORD of hosts will do this.

Jer 25:35 And the shepherds will have no way to flee, Nor the leaders of the flock to *escape*.

Jer 50:29 "Call together the archers against Babylon. All you who bend the bow, encamp against it all around; Let none of them *escape*. Repay her according to her work; According to all she has done, do to her; For she has been proud against the LORD, Against the Holy One of Israel.

Ezek 14:22 "Yet behold, there shall be left in it a *remnant* who will be brought out, *both* sons and daughters; surely they will come out to you, and you will see their ways and their doings. Then you will be comforted concerning the disaster that I have brought upon Jerusalem, all that I have brought upon it.

Dan 11:42 "He shall stretch out his hand against the countries, and the land of Egypt shall not *escape*.

Joel 2:3 A fire devours before them, And behind them a flame burns; The land *is* like the Garden of Eden before them, And behind them a desolate wilderness; Surely nothing shall *escape* them.

Joel 2:32 And it shall come to pass *That* whoever calls on the name of the LORD Shall be saved. For in Mount Zion and in Jerusalem there shall be *deliverance*, As the LORD has said, Among the remnant whom the LORD calls.
