[Fri] ἄφεσις, εως, ἡ (1) of captivity release, liberation, deliverance (LU 4.18); (2) of an obligation or debt cancellation, pardon; (3) predominately in relation to sins forgiveness, cancellation of guilt (MT 26.28); in the new covenant, ἀ. involves not a passing over of sins as in the old covenant (cf. πάρεσις [passing over, overlooking] in RO 3.25), but their removal from the mind of God, taking away (HE 10.18; cf. 10.3)
