#### Colossians 1:9-12

# 2. Paul's Asking

#### End result - in order that you might be filled with the complete knowledge of His will (desire)

and to ask that you may be filled with the knowledge of His will καὶ αἰτούμενοι, ἵνα πληρωθῆτε τὴν ἐπίγνωσιν τοῦ θελήματος αὐτοῦ

- Subjunctive possible but not guaranteed
  - Requires prayer asking God for help
  - Requires purpose choosing to desire this
- Subjective each individual receiving "precise and correct knowledge" [Thayer]

### Three Areas of Prayer for Spiritual Growth

## A. Worthy Walking

in all wisdom and spiritual understanding; that you may walk worthy of the Lord, fully pleasing [Him], ἐν πάση σοφία καὶ συνέσει πνευματική, περιπατήσαι ἀξίως τοῦ κυρίου εἰς πᾶσαν ἀρεσκείαν,

- In all wisdom and spiritual understanding principles
- To be walking principled practice
  - Col 2:6 faithful, informed walking
  - Col 3:7 former walking
  - Col 4:5 strategic walking
- Worthy of the Lord principled practice for a purpose
  - o Eph 4:1 walk worthy of your calling
  - Phil 1:17 walk worthy of the gospel of Christ (in unity)
  - o 1 Thes 2:12 walk worthy of the God who calls you
- Unto all [things] a desire to please intent to please in every area at all times

### B. Fruitful Working

being fruitful in every good work and increasing in the knowledge of God; έν παντὶ ἔργω ἀγαθῷ καρποφοροῦντες καὶ αὐξανόμενοι τῆ ἐπιγνώσει τοῦ θεοῦ,

- In each good work extent
  - o Col 1:21 former working
  - Col 3:17 worshipful working
- Being fruitful
  - Luke 8:15 fruitful soil hearing, holding, bearing
- Being increased in the knowledge of God (doing brings learning Heb 5)
  - Col 2:19 growth of the body happens as the body parts work together
  - o 1 Pet 2:2 desire the Word, that you may be increased by it

### C. Empowered Doing

- In every ability (effort?)
- Enabled

- Resource God's might (dominion)
  - **Eph 6:10** Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord and in the power of His might. Τοῦ λοιποῦ, ἐνδυναμοῦσθε ἐν κυρίφ καὶ ἐν τῷ κράτει τῆς ἰσχύος αὐτοῦ.
