WHAT

- To proclaim the Word
- To *present* yourself ready in any situation
- To *point out* sinful action
- To prohibit bad action
- To *push* people to action

HOW

- By giving plenty of *time*
- By giving plenty of teaching

WHY

- Because they will reject sound teaching
- Because they will chase many teachers
- Because they will *turn from* the truth
- Because they will be *turned aside* to myths
