

Study of "Deny" in the New Testament:

ἀρνέομαι (arneomai) – to deny (33x in 30 verses)

Friberg, *Analytical Greek Lexicon* (1) in relation to a question or demand *deny* (LU 8.45), opposite *ὁμολογέω* (*admit, confess*); (2) in relation to a claim *refuse, disown, not consent to* (HE 11.24); (3) in relation to God or a person *deny, disown, renounce* (1J 2.23); (4) in relation to the Christian faith, usually in the sense of apostasy *deny, repudiate* (1T 5.8); (5) as saying no to oneself in order to live wholly for Christ *disregard, pay no attention to one's own desires* (LU 9.23); as turning from ungodly conduct *renounce, deny* (1T 2.12); (6) as acting contrary to one's true character *be untrue, be false to oneself* (2T 2.13)

1. The Denial of Moses' _____

Acts 7:35 This Moses whom they **rejected**, saying, 'Who made you a ruler and a judge?' is the one God sent to *be* a ruler and a deliverer by the hand of the Angel who appeared to him in the bush.

2. John the Baptist Confessing His _____

Jn 1:20 He confessed, and did not **deny**, but confessed, "I am not the Christ."

3. Denial of Responsibility for an _____

Lk 8:45 And Jesus said, "Who touched Me?" When all **denied** it, Peter and those with him said, "Master, the multitudes ... press You, and You say, 'Who touched Me?'"

4. Peter's Denial of Knowing _____

Mt 26:70 But he **denied** it before *them* all, saying, "I do not know what you are saying."

Mt 26:72 But again he **denied** with an oath, "I do not know the Man!"

Mk 14:68 But he **denied** it, saying, "I neither know nor understand what you are saying." And he went out on the porch, and a rooster crowed.

Mk 14:70 But he **denied** it again. And a little later those who stood by said to Peter again, "Surely you are *one* of them; for you are a Galilean, and your speech shows *it*."

Lk 22:57 But he **denied** Him, saying, "Woman, I do not know Him."

Jn 13:38 Jesus answered him, "Will you lay down your life for My sake? Most assuredly, I say to you, the rooster shall not crow till you have **denied** Me three times.

Jn 18:25 Now Simon Peter stood and warmed himself. Therefore they said to him, "You are not also *one* of His disciples, are you?" He **denied** *it* and said, "I am not!"

Jn 18:27 Peter then **denied** again; and immediately a rooster crowed.

5. Denial of _____ by the Jews

Acts 3:13 "The God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, the God of our fathers, glorified His Servant Jesus, whom you delivered up and **denied** in the presence of Pilate, when he was determined to let *Him* go.

Acts 3:14 "But you **denied** the Holy One and the Just, and asked for a murderer to be granted to you,

6. The Inability to _____ the Miraculous

Acts 4:16 saying, "What shall we do to these men? For, indeed, that a notable miracle has been done through them *is* evident to all who dwell in Jerusalem, and we cannot **deny** *it*."

7. The Denial of Jesus by _____ Teachers

2 Pet 2:1 But there were also false prophets among the people, even as there will be false teachers among you, who will secretly bring in destructive heresies, even **denying** the Lord who bought them, and bring on themselves swift destruction.

Jude 1:4 For certain men have crept in unnoticed, who long ago were marked out for this condemnation, ungodly men, who turn the grace of our God into lewdness and **deny** the only Lord God and our Lord Jesus Christ.

8. The Denial of the _____ of Jesus as the Christ

1 Jn 2:22 Who is a liar but he who **denies** that Jesus is the Christ? He is antichrist who denies the Father and the Son.

1 Jn 2:23 Whoever **denies** the Son does not have the Father either; he who acknowledges the Son has the Father also.

9. Denial of God by One's _____

Titus 1:16 They profess to know God, but in works they **deny** *Him*, being abominable, disobedient, and disqualified for every good work.

10. Denial of the Faith by One's _____

1 Tim 5:8 But if anyone does not provide for his own, and especially for those of his household, he has **denied** the faith and is worse than an unbeliever.

11. The Denial of the Purpose and _____ of God

2 Tim 3:5 having a form of godliness but **denying** its power. ...from such...turn away!

12. Remaining _____ Instead of Turning Away from God

Rev 2:13 I know your works, and where you dwell, where Satan's throne *is*. And you hold fast to My name, and did not **deny** My faith even in the days in which Antipas was My faithful martyr, who was killed among you, where Satan dwells.

Rev 3:8 I know your works....I have set before you an open door, and no one can shut it; for you have a little strength, have kept My word, and have not **denied** My name.

13. Denying God Before _____ (& before the Father & the angels)

Mt 10:33 "But whoever **denies** Me before men, him I will also **deny** before My Father who is in heaven.

Lk 12:9 But he who **denies** Me before men will be **denied** before the angels of God.

14. _____ Up on God (the opposite of "endure")

2 Tim 2:12 If we endure, We shall also reign with *Him*. If we **deny** *Him*, He also will **deny** us.

15. The Inability of God to Deny _____

2 Tim 2:13 If we are faithless, He remains faithful; He cannot **deny** Himself.

16. The _____ of Every Believer to Reject Self & externals

Lk 9:23 Then He said to *them* all, "If anyone desires to come after Me, let him **deny** himself, and take up his cross daily, and follow Me.

Tit 2:12 teaching us that, **denying** ungodliness and worldly lusts, we should live soberly, righteously, and godly in the present age,

Heb 11:24 By faith Moses ... **refused** to be called the son of Pharaoh's daughter,
