		Gaebelein – (Matt 9:14-17) A change of dispensation is indicated by Him in verses 16-17. The old garment and the old bottles (Literal: wine-skins) stand for the law with its ordinances. The piece of the new cloth and the new wine stand for the better righteousness, the gospel. The old wine-skins and the new wine do not go together; neither do law and grace.  Unger – (36-38) Figuratively, the old cloth and old wineskins (Judaistic legalism) must not be mixed with the new cloth and new wine (the gospel of grace, John 1:17), ushered in by the redemptive death of the Son of Man. One supersedes the other, and they are mutually exclusive and unmixable.
