## John 11:21-45

- $^{21}$  Then Martha said to Jesus, "Lord, if You had been here, my brother would not have died.
- <sup>22</sup> "But even now I know that whatever You ask of God, God will give You."
- <sup>23</sup> Jesus said to her, "Your brother will rise again."
- <sup>24</sup> Martha said to Him, "I know that he will rise again in the resurrection at the last day."
- $^{25}$  Jesus said to her, "I am the resurrection and the life. He who believes in Me, though he may die, he shall live.
- <sup>26</sup> "And whoever lives and believes in Me shall never die. Do you believe this?"
- $^{27}$  She said to Him, "Yes, Lord, I believe that You are the Christ, the Son of God, who is to come into the world."
- <sup>28</sup> And when she had said these things, she went her way and secretly called Mary her sister, saying, "The Teacher has come and is calling for you."
- <sup>29</sup> As soon as she heard *that*, she arose quickly and came to Him.

- <sup>41</sup> Then they took away the stone *from the place* where the dead man was lying<sup>1</sup>. And Jesus lifted up *His* eyes and said, "Father, I thank You that You have heard Me.
- <sup>42</sup> "And I know that You always hear Me, but because of the people who are standing by I said *this*, that they may believe that You sent Me."
- <sup>43</sup> Now when He had said these things, He cried with a loud voice, "Lazarus, come forth!"
- $^{\rm 44}$  And he who had died came out bound hand and foot with graveclothes, and his face was wrapped with a cloth. Jesus said to them, "Loose him, and let him go."
- $^{45}$  Then many of the Jews who had come to Mary, and had seen the things Jesus did, believed in Him.
