Biblical Life Change: How the Truth Changes Our Lives (Deuteronomy 5:1)

And Moses called all Israel, and said to them: Hear, O Israel, the statutes and judgments which I speak in your hearing today, that you may learn them and be careful to observe them.

We Must HEAR God's Word

1. Active Gathering

Heb 10:25 not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as *is* the manner of some, but exhorting *one another*, and so much the more as you see the Day approaching.

2. Attentive Listening

"Hear, O Israel, the statutes and judgments which I speak in your hearing today" Noise or listening? Note-taking... Discipline (media dulled) – ADD – overstimulation

3. Appropriate Teachers

Eph 4:11-12 And He Himself gave some *to be* apostles, some prophets, some evangelists, and some pastors and teachers, for the equipping of the saints for the work of ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ,

James 3:1 My brethren, let not many of you become teachers, knowing that we shall receive a stricter judgment.

Neh 8:8 So they read distinctly from the book, in the Law of God; and they gave the sense, and helped *them* to understand the reading.

4. Accurate Teaching

2 Tim 2:15 Be diligent to present yourself approved to God, a worker who does not need to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth.

Most sermons end here...

We Must LEARN God's Word (have it with you – tying shoes)

1. A <u>Purposing</u> Heart (listening in order to learn and obey)

1 Pet 2:1-2 Therefore, laying aside all malice, all deceit, hypocrisy, envy, and all evil speaking, as newborn babes, desire the pure milk of the word, that you may grow thereby *(keep focusing on it until it works)*

2. A Preserving Heart (Psalm 119:11)

Psalms 119:11 Your word I have hidden in my heart, That I might not sin against You!

3. A <u>Pondering</u> Heart (Joshua 1:8; Ps 1:1-3; 119:18)

Joshua 1:8 This Book of the Law shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate in it day and night, that you may observe to do according to all Northridge Baptist Church – Pastor Kevin Subra – January 2, 2011

that is written in it. For then you will make your way prosperous, and then you will have good success. *(not supplement but the very essence of life)*

Psalms 1:1-3 ¹ Blessed *is* the man Who walks not in the counsel of the ungodly, Nor stands in the path of sinners, Nor sits in the seat of the scornful; ² But his delight *is* in the law of the Lord, And in His law he meditates day and night. ³ He shall be like a tree Planted by the rivers of water, That brings forth its fruit in its season, Whose leaf also shall not wither; And whatever he does shall prosper.

Psalms 119:18 Open my eyes, that I may see Wondrous things from Your law. **Psalms 119:34** Give me understanding, and I shall keep Your law; Indeed, I shall observe it with *my* whole heart.

We Must OBSERVE God's Word

1. Diligent Observation of Your Circumstances

James 1:22-24 But be doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves. For if anyone is a hearer of the word and not a doer, he is like a man observing his natural face in a mirror; for he observes himself, goes away, and immediately forgets what kind of man he was.

2. Diligent Identification of Truth-Affected Areas

- Relationships with God and people
- Habits places you go, friends you keep, actions you practice
- Speech what you say/don't say, wrong words (he made me mad)
- Attitudes what I think, why I do what I do, perspective on trials
- Decisions the process by which I make a choice God's input

3. Diligent Integration of Truth

James 1:21-22 Therefore lay aside all filthiness and overflow of wickedness, and receive with meekness the implanted word, which is able to save your souls. But be doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves.

Eph 4:22-24 that you put off, concerning your former conduct, the old man which grows corrupt according to the deceitful lusts, and be renewed in the spirit of your mind, and that you put on the new man which was created according to God, in true righteousness and holiness.

Rom 12:1-2 I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that you present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God, *which is* your reasonable service. And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what *is* that good and acceptable and perfect will of God.
