# Two Ways to Live: Choose Wisely!

#### Psalm 1

### 1. What is the theme of Psalm 1? (v.6) Two Ways of Living

- Way = lifestyle; what you DO; practices, habits, focuses, actions
- Way ≠ your intentions, hopes, wishes, dreams, expectations

### 2. What are the two ways of living? (v.6)

- The way of the righteous
- The way of the ungodly

There are only TWO choices; two ways. You are either walking in one way or the other. There is no third option. Which way describes YOUR walk?

## 3. How does God view these two ways? (v. 6)

- He knows the way of the righteous
  - o God acknowledges and approves of this way
  - o God is intimately connected with this way
- He rejects the way of the ungodly
  - o God does not accept, acknowledge, or approve of this way
  - o This way will eventually vanish (it cannot and will not last)

# 4. What is the way of the ungodly? (v. 4-5)

- Actions: It is opposite of the righteous way (cf. v. 1-3)
  - Not separate
  - o No immersed by the Word
  - Not stable
  - Not fruitful
  - Not valuable or lasting
- Results: It is measured by its eternal end (cp. Psalm 10...)
  - The ungodly shall not stand in judgment
  - o Sinners will be excluded from the presence of the righteous

### 5. What is the way of the righteous? (v. 1-3)

- A. Negative Actions (v. 1):
  - o Rejects the input of the ungodly
  - o Rejects the paths of the sinner
  - Rejects the practices of the scornful
- B. Positive Actions (v. 2):
  - o <u>Delights</u> in the Law of the Lord
  - Meditates in the Law of the Lord constantly

#### C. Present Results:

- This way brings God's blessing (v. 1)
- o This way brings growth (v. 3)
- This way brings stability (v. 3)
- This way brings fruitfulness (v. 3)
- This way brings health (v. 3)
- This way brings prosperity (v. 3)
- o This way brings God's acknowledgement & approval (v. 6)
- D. Eternal Results (v. 5):
  - Approval in judgment
  - o Gathering with the righteous

Which way describes your way?

Do you need to change directions?

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup> Blessed *is* the man Who walks not in the counsel of the ungodly, Nor stands in the path of sinners, Nor sits in the seat of the scornful;

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>2</sup> But his delight *is* in the law of the LORD, And in His law he meditates day and night.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>3</sup> He shall be like a tree Planted by the rivers of water, That brings forth its fruit in its season, Whose leaf also shall not wither; And whatever he does shall prosper.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>4</sup> The ungodly *are* not so, But *are* like the chaff which the wind drives away.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>5</sup> Therefore the ungodly shall not stand in the judgment, Nor sinners in the congregation of the righteous.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>6</sup> For the LORD knows the way of the righteous, But the way of the ungodly shall perish.
