PROVERBS 31: A Mother's Lessons to Her Child (Part 3)

- ¹ The words of King Lemuel, the utterance (massa) which his mother taught him:
- The word translated "utterance" is massa, a name of a son of Ishmael. It is likely that this is written to a descendant of Massa, and king of a tribe in north Arabia (Gen 25:14; 1 Chr 1:30).
- Thus, "The words of Lemuel, king of Massa, with which his mother instructed him."
- This is a record of the active <u>influence</u> of a mother towards her son, and indicates a range of topics about which a mother can influence her children.
