1. The Prohibition: Taking God's Name in Vain

The Meaning of the Name of God

- His actual <u>name</u>
- What God's name <u>represents</u> as He has <u>revealed</u> Himself to be.

The Meaning of "Vain"

- <u>Empty</u>
- Worthless
- Common

Other Translations

- Holman Christian Standard Bible: "Do not misuse the name of the LORD your God..."
- Youngs Literal Translation "Thou dost not take up the name of Jehovah thy God for a vain thing"
- NIV1984 "You shall not <u>misuse</u> the name of the LORD your God,"

2. MY WORDS: What I Say

- As an <u>oath</u> (Deut 6:13)
 - a. Swearing by God's name something to be true when it is not
 - b. Swearing by God's name for trivial matters
 - c. God's Command Speak the <u>Truth</u> Always

Matt 5:33-37 ³³ "Again you have heard that it was said to those of old, `You shall not swear falsely, but shall perform your oaths to the Lord.' ³⁴ "But I say to you, do not swear at all: neither by heaven, for it is God's throne; ³⁵ "nor by the earth, for it is His footstool; nor by Jerusalem, for it is the city of the great King. ³⁶ "Nor shall you swear by your head, because you cannot make one hair white or black. ³⁷ "But let your `Yes' be `Yes,' and your `No,' `No.' For whatever is more than these is from the evil one.

As a condemnation

Eph 4:29 Let no corrupt word proceed out of your mouth, but what is good for necessary edification, that it may impart grace to the hearers.

James 3:10 Out of the same mouth proceed blessing and cursing. My brethren, these things ought not to be so.

As a <u>triviality</u> or <u>filler</u>

3. MY ACCURACY: Who I Am Talking About, and How I Talk About Him

- Not a <u>facade</u> of <u>fakery</u>
- Not an excuse for unbiblical actions
- As an <u>accurate</u> <u>statement</u> of Who God is by how I talk about Him

4. MY ACTIONS: Who I Represent

- Understanding that all that I do represents God
- As a central focus of my life, thoughts, and actions

NKJ "In this manner, therefore, pray: Our Father in heaven, Hallowed be Your name.

NET So pray this way: Our Father in heaven, may your name be honored,

^{CSB} "Therefore, you should pray like this: Our Father in heaven, Your name be honored as holy.

5. The Penalty: Punishment

New American Standard Bible 1995 " for the LORD will not leave him unpunished who takes His name in vain. Youngs "for Jehovah acquitteth not him who taketh up His name for a vain thing."

Phil 2:9-11 ⁹ Therefore God also has highly exalted Him and given Him the name which is above every name, ¹⁰ that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of those in heaven, and of those on earth, and of those under the earth, ¹¹ and *that* every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ *is* Lord, to the glory of God the Father.
