Then the LORD spoke to Moses, saying: ²² "Also take a census of the sons of Gershon, by their fathers' house, by their families. ²³ "From thirty years old and above, even to fifty years old, you shall number them, all who enter to perform the service, to do the work in the tabernacle of meeting. ²⁴ "This <i>is</i> the service of the families of the Gershonites, in serving and carrying: ²⁵ "They shall carry the curtains of the tabernacle and the tabernacle of meeting <i>with</i> its covering, the covering of badger skins that <i>is</i> on it, the screen for the door of the tabernacle of meeting, ²⁶ "the screen for the door of the gate of the court, the hangings of the court which <i>are</i> around the tabernacle and altar, and their cords, all the furnishings for their service and all that is made for these things: so shall they serve. ²⁷ "Aaron and his sons shall assign all the service of the sons of the Gershonites, all their tasks and all their service. And you shall appoint to them all their tasks as their duty. ²⁸ "This <i>is</i> the service of the families of the sons of Gershon in the tabernacle of meeting.
