- 1. God Who Will Serve in the Tabernacle
 Why? Because others tried to usurp the priest's
 position
 - a. The priests will _____ the iniquity of the tabernacle
 - The priest need to bear the iniquity that their sinfulness brings upon the tabernacle – i.e. they are responsible themselves for their own atonement
 - The priests alone were responsible for to make atonement for all the sins of the nation
 - This seems to emphasis that the priest have this unique role.
 - b. The Levites shall _____ with the priests
 - They attend to the needs of the priests and of the tabernacle
 - Outsider someone not of the tribe of Levi
 - God calls them a gift to the priests
 - c. The Levites shall not come _____ the priestly articles.
 - d. This is to _____ the Israelites lest they die
- 'Therefore you and your sons with you shall attend to your priesthood for everything at the altar and behind the veil; and you shall serve. I give your priesthood to you as a gift for service, but the outsider who comes near shall be put to death." ⁸ And the LORD spoke to Aaron: "Here, I Myself have also given you charge of My heave offerings, all the holy gifts of the children of Israel; I have given them as a portion to you and your sons, as an ordinance forever. ⁹ "This shall be yours of the most holy things reserved from the fire: every offering of theirs, every grain offering and every sin offering and every trespass offering which they render to Me, shall be most holy for you and your sons. 10 "In a most holy place you shall eat it; every male shall eat it. It shall be holy to you. ¹¹ "This also is yours: the heave offering of their gift, with all the wave offerings of the children of Israel; I have given them to you, and your sons and daughters with you, as an ordinance forever. Everyone who is clean in your house may eat it. ¹² "All the best of the oil, all the best of the new wine and the grain, their firstfruits which they offer to the LORD, I have given them to you. ¹³ "Whatever first ripe fruit is in their land, which they bring to the LORD, shall be yours.  - The grain, sin, and trespass offerings are reserved for the priests
 - The heave and wave offerings, along with the oil, wine and first fruit offerings are for all who are clean within the family

15 "Everything that first opens the womb of all flesh, which they bring to the LORD, whether man or beast, shall be yours; nevertheless the firstborn of man you shall surely redeem, and the firstborn of unclean animals you shall redeem. ¹⁶ "And those redeemed of the devoted things you shall redeem when one month old, according to your valuation, for five shekels of silver, according to the shekel of the sanctuary, which is twenty GERAHS. ¹⁷ "But the firstborn of a cow, the firstborn of a sheep, or the firstborn of a goat you shall not redeem; they are holy. You shall sprinkle their blood on the altar, and burn their fat as an offering made by fire for a sweet aroma to the LORD. ¹⁸ "And their flesh shall be yours, just as the wave breast and the right thigh are yours. ¹⁹ "All the heave offerings of the holy things, which the children of Israel offer to the LORD, I have given to you and your sons and daughters with you as an ordinance forever; it is a covenant of salt forever before the LORD with you and your descendants with you."

²⁰ Then the LORD said to Aaron: "You shall have no inheritance in their land, nor shall you have any portion among them; I *am* your portion and your inheritance among the children of Israel. ²¹ " Behold, I have given the children of Levi all the tithes in Israel as an inheritance in return for the work which they perform, the work of the tabernacle of meeting. ²² "Hereafter the children of Israel shall not come near the tabernacle of meeting, lest they bear sin and die. ²³ "But the Levites shall perform the work of the tabernacle of meeting, and they shall bear their iniquity; *it shall be* a statute forever, throughout your generations, that among the children of Israel they shall have no inheritance. ²⁴ "For the tithes of the children of Israel, which they offer up *as* a heave offering to the LORD, I have given to the Levites as an inheritance; therefore I have said to them, 'Among the children of Israel they shall have no inheritance.' "
