kills a person accidentally may flee there. ¹⁶ ' But if he strikes him

with an iron implement, so that he dies, he *is* a murderer; the murderer shall surely be put to death. ¹⁷ 'And if he strikes him with a stone in the hand, by which one could die, and he does die, he *is* a murderer; the murderer shall surely be put to death. ¹⁸ 'Or *if* he strikes him with a wooden hand weapon, by which one could die, and he does die, he *is* a murderer; the murderer shall surely be put to death. ¹⁹ 'The avenger of blood himself shall put the murderer to death; when he meets him, he shall put him to death. ²⁰ 'If he pushes him out of hatred or, while lying in wait, hurls something at him so that he dies, ²¹ 'or in enmity he strikes him with his hand so that he dies, the one who struck *him* shall surely be put to death. He *is* a murderer. The avenger of blood shall put the murderer to death when he meets him.

- ²² 'However, if he pushes him suddenly without enmity, or throws anything at him without lying in wait, ²³ 'or uses a stone, by which a man could die, throwing *it* at him without seeing *him*, so that he dies, while he was not his enemy or seeking his harm, ²⁴ 'then the congregation shall judge between the manslayer and the avenger of blood according to these judgments. ²⁵ 'So the congregation shall deliver the manslayer from the hand of the avenger of blood, and the congregation shall return him to the city of refuge where he had fled, and he shall remain there until the death of the high priest who was anointed with the holy oil.
- ²⁶ 'But if the manslayer at any time goes outside the limits of the city of refuge where he fled, ²⁷ 'and the avenger of blood finds him outside the limits of his city of refuge, and the avenger of blood kills the manslayer, he shall not be guilty of blood, ²⁸ 'because he should have remained in his city of refuge until the death of the high priest. But after the death of the high priest the manslayer may return to the land of his possession. ²⁹ ' And these *things* shall be a statute of judgment to you throughout your generations in all your dwellings.
- ³⁰ 'Whoever kills a person, the murderer shall be put to death on the testimony of witnesses; but one witness is not *sufficient* testimony against a person for the death *penalty.*³¹ 'Moreover you shall take no ransom for the life of a murderer who *is* guilty of death, but he shall surely be put to death.

 ³² 'And you shall take no ransom for him who has fled to his city of refuge, that he may return to dwell in the land before the death of the priest.

 ³³ 'So you shall not pollute the land where you *are;* for blood defiles the land, and no atonement can be made for the land, for the blood that is shed on it, except by the blood of him who shed it.

 ³⁴ 'Therefore do not defile the land which you inhabit, in the midst of which I dwell; for I the LORD dwell among the children of Israel.' "

- . Who may not flee there:
 - One who uses a "weapon"
 - An iron implement
 - A stone
 - A wooden weapon
 - One who pushes someone out of hatred
 - One who ambushes someone
 - One who strikes someone in enmity

These conditions make the person a murderer

- d. The person who is the avenger of blood will put the murderer to death.
- e. Additional conditions:
 - One who pushes someone suddenly without enmity
 - One who throws a stone at someone he does not see.
- f. The congregation will judge between the manslayer and the avenger of blood.
- g. If the manslayer id found to not be a murderer:
 - They will deliver him from the avenger of blood
 - They will return him to the city of refuge
 - He will stay there until the current high priest dies.
- 7. What if the Manslayer _____ the City of Refuge?
 - a. Before the High Priest dies, if the avenger of blood finds him:
 - If the avenger of blood finds him and kills him, he will not be guilty of murder
 - Why? Because the manslayer had a responsibility to stay in the city.

- He may return to his possession.
 - for Putting a Murderer to Death
- a. There must be witnesses to convict a murderer.
 - There must be more than one witness.
- b. They will take no ransom for the life of a murderer
- c. They will take no ransom for the manslayer

He must be put to death

- He will be allowed to stay in the city of refuge until the priest dies, then he may return to his possession.
- d. The land must be atoned for any blood shed on it.
 - The only blood which may atone for it is the blood of the murderer.
 - This process is given to keep the land from being defiled.

- When some one purposefully takes someone else's life, God required them to atone with their own life.
