**Joshua 17:11-13** <sup>11</sup> And in Issachar and in Asher, Manasseh had Beth Shean and its towns, Ibleam and its towns, the inhabitants of Dor and its towns, the inhabitants of En Dor and its towns, the inhabitants of Taanach and its towns, and the inhabitants of Megiddo and its towns -- three hilly regions. <sup>12</sup> Yet the children of Manasseh could

not drive out *the inhabitants of* those cities, but the Canaanites were determined to dwell in that land. <sup>13</sup> And it happened, when the children of Israel grew strong, that they put the Canaanites to forced labor, but did not utterly drive them out.

**Judges 2:20-23** <sup>20</sup> Then the anger of the LORD was hot against Israel; and He said, "Because this nation has transgressed My covenant which I commanded their fathers, and has not heeded My voice, <sup>21</sup> "I also will no longer drive out before them any of the nations which Joshua left when he died, <sup>22</sup> "so that through them I may test Israel, whether they will keep the ways of the LORD, to walk in them as their fathers kept *them*, or not." <sup>23</sup> Therefore the LORD left those nations, without driving them out immediately; nor did He deliver them into the hand of Joshua.

Joshua 17:14-18 <sup>14</sup> Then the children of Joseph spoke to Joshua, saying, "Why have you given us *only* one lot and one share to inherit, since we *are* a great people, inasmuch as the LORD has blessed us until now?" <sup>15</sup> So Joshua answered them, "If you *are* a great people, *then* go up to the forest *country* and clear a place for yourself there in the land of the Perizzites and the giants, since the mountains of Ephraim are too confined for you." <sup>16</sup> But the children of Joseph said, "The mountain country is not enough for us; and all the Canaanites who dwell in the land of the valley have chariots of iron, *both those* who *are* of Beth Shean and its towns and *those* who *are* of the Valley of Jezreel." <sup>17</sup> And Joshua spoke to the house of Joseph -- to Ephraim and Manasseh -- saying, "You *are* a great people and have great power; you shall not have *only* one lot, <sup>18</sup> "but the mountain country shall be yours. Although it *is* wooded, you shall cut it down, and its farthest extent shall be yours; for you shall drive out the Canaanites, though they have iron chariots *and* are strong."

Joshua 18:1-7 Now the whole congregation of the children of Israel assembled together at Shiloh, and set up the tabernacle of meeting there. And the land was subdued before them. <sup>2</sup> But there remained among the Northridge Baptist Church – Sunday School – Sean Kelly – 2018

children of Israel seven tribes which had not yet received their inheritance. <sup>3</sup> Then Joshua said to the children of Israel: "How long will you neglect to go and possess the land which the LORD God of your fathers has given you? <sup>4</sup> "Pick out from among you three men for *each* tribe, and I will send them; they shall rise and go through the land, survey it according to their inheritance, and come *back* to me. <sup>5</sup> "And they shall divide it into seven parts. Judah shall remain in their territory on the south, and the house of Joseph shall remain in their territory on the north. <sup>6</sup> "You shall therefore survey the land in seven parts and bring *the survey* here to me, that I may cast lots for you here before the LORD our God. <sup>7</sup> "But the Levites have no part among you, for the priesthood of the LORD *is* their inheritance. And Gad, Reuben, and half the tribe of Manasseh have received their inheritance beyond the Jordan on the east, which Moses the servant of the LORD gave them."

- E. Judah, Joseph, Gad and Reuben had all received their inheritance


