Bible Reading - Familiarization - Knowing What the Bible Says

Matt 22:29 Jesus answered and said to them, "You are mistaken, not knowing the Scriptures nor the power of God."

PUBLIC BIBLE READING (reading out loud in a group setting)

Neh 8:3 the ears of all the people were [attentive] to the Book of the Law.

- We are to pay attention with our ears.
- This would include being quiet, and thinking about what is being read.

Neh 8:8 So they read distinctly from the book,...

- We need to learn to read.
- We need to learn to read well.
- We need to learn to read clearly.

Neh 9:1-3 ...the children of Israel were assembled... <u>separated themselves</u> from all foreigners... and they... <u>confessed their sins</u>... and ... they <u>stood up</u> in their place and <u>read from the Book of the Law</u> ...[for one-fourth] of the day; and [for another] fourth they <u>confessed</u> and <u>worshiped</u> the LORD their God.

- We are to approach the Word with a clean heart (they separated themselves and started with confession – see 1 Peter 2:1-3)
- We are to show respect for the Word (they stood and listened).
- We are to listen with the purpose of changing our minds and actions (they confessed).
- We are to learn about the Lord and respond to Him as He deserves (they worshiped).

Col 4:16 Now when this epistle is read among you, <u>see that it is read</u> also in the church of the Laodiceans, and that you likewise read the epistle from Laodicea.

- The Bible is intended to be read out loud when believers assemble.
- We are commanded to read the Bible when believers gather together.
 - 1 Thes 5:27 I charge you by the Lord that this epistle be read to all the holy brethren.
 - **1 Tim 4:13** Till I come, give attention to <u>reading</u>, to exhortation, to doctrine.
