Care in Old Age	<p>Mark 7:5-13 ⁵ Then the Pharisees and scribes asked Him, "Why do Your disciples not walk according to the tradition of the elders, but eat bread with unwashed hands?"</p> <p>⁶ He answered and said to them, "Well did Isaiah prophesy of you hypocrites, as it is written: 'This people honors Me with <i>their</i> lips, But their heart is far from Me.</p> <p>⁷ And in vain they worship Me, Teaching as doctrines the commandments of men.'</p> <p>⁸ "For laying aside the commandment of God, you hold the tradition of men-- the washing of pitchers and cups, and many other such things you do."</p> <p>⁹ He said to them, "All too well you reject the commandment of God, that you may keep your tradition.</p> <p>¹⁰ "For Moses said, 'Honor your father and your mother'; and, 'He who curses father or mother, let him be put to death.'</p> <p>¹¹ "But you say, 'If a man says to his father or mother, "Whatever profit you might have received from me <i>is</i> Corban"-- '(that is, a gift <i>to God</i>),</p> <p>¹² "then you no longer let him do anything for his father or his mother,</p> <p>¹³ "making the word of God of no effect through your tradition which you have handed down. And many such things you do."</p>
Care in Old Age	<p>Mat 15:1-9 Then the scribes and Pharisees who were from Jerusalem came to Jesus, saying, ² "Why do Your disciples transgress the tradition of the elders? For they do not wash their hands when they eat bread." ³ He answered and said to them, "Why do you also transgress the commandment of God because of your tradition? ⁴ "For God commanded, saying, 'Honor your father and your mother'; and, 'He who curses father or mother, let him be put to death.' ⁵ "But you say, 'Whoever says to his father or mother, "Whatever profit you might have received from me <i>is</i> a gift <i>to God</i>"-- ⁶ 'then he need not honor his father or mother.' Thus you have made the commandment of God of no effect by your tradition.</p> <p>⁷ "Hypocrites! Well did Isaiah prophesy about you, saying: ⁸ 'These people draw near to Me with their mouth, And honor Me with <i>their</i> lips, But their heart is far from Me. ⁹ And in vain they worship Me, Teaching as doctrines the commandments of men.'"</p>
Command	<p>Ex 20:12 Honor your father and your mother, that your days may be long upon the land which the LORD your God is giving you.</p>
Command	<p>Deut 5:16 'Honor your father and your mother, as the LORD your God has commanded you, that your days may be long, and that it may be well with you in the land which the LORD your God is giving you.</p>
Command	<p>Matt 15:4 "For God commanded, saying, 'Honor your father and your mother'; and, 'He who curses father or mother, let him be put to death.'</p> <p>(ESV) For God commanded, 'Honor your father and your mother,' and, 'Whoever reviles father or mother must surely die.'</p> <p>ὁ γὰρ θεὸς εἶπεν· τίμα τὸν πατέρα καὶ τὴν μητέρα, καί· ὁ κακολογῶν πατέρα ἢ μητέρα θανάτῳ τελευτάτω.</p>
Command	<p>Matt 15:6 'then he need not honor his father or mother.' Thus you have made the commandment of God of no effect by your tradition.</p> <p>(ESV) he need not honor his father.' So for the sake of your tradition you have made void the word of God.</p> <p>οὐ μὴ τιμήσει τὸν πατέρα αὐτοῦ· καὶ ἠκυρώσατε τὸν λόγον τοῦ θεοῦ διὰ τὴν παράδοσιν ὑμῶν.</p>
Command	<p>Matt 19:16-19 ¹⁶ Now behold, one came and said to Him, "Good Teacher, what good thing shall I do that I may have eternal life?" So He said to him, "Why do you call Me good? No one <i>is</i> good but One, <i>that is</i>, God. But if you want to enter into life, keep the commandments." ¹⁸ He said to Him, "Which ones?" Jesus said, "'You shall not murder,' 'You shall not commit adultery,' 'You shall not steal,' 'You shall not bear false witness,' ¹⁹ 'Honor your father and <i>your</i> mother,' and, 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself.'"</p>

Command	<p>Mark 10:17-23 ¹⁷ Now as He was going out on the road, one came running, knelt before Him, and asked Him, "Good Teacher, what shall I do that I may inherit eternal life?"</p> <p>¹⁸ So Jesus said to him, "Why do you call Me good? No one <i>is</i> good but One, <i>that is</i>, God.</p> <p>¹⁹ "You know the commandments: 'Do not commit adultery,' 'Do not murder,' 'Do not steal,' 'Do not bear false witness,' 'Do not defraud,' 'Honor your father and your mother.'"</p> <p>²⁰ And he answered and said to Him, "Teacher, all these things I have kept from my youth."</p> <p>²¹ Then Jesus, looking at him, loved him, and said to him, "One thing you lack: Go your way, sell whatever you have and give to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven; and come, take up the cross, and follow Me."</p> <p>²² But he was sad at this word, and went away sorrowful, for he had great possessions.</p> <p>²³ Then Jesus looked around and said to His disciples, "How hard it is for those who have riches to enter the kingdom of God!"</p>
Command	<p>Luke 18:18-23 ¹⁸ Now a certain ruler asked Him, saying, "Good Teacher, what shall I do to inherit eternal life?"</p> <p>¹⁹ So Jesus said to him, "Why do you call Me good? No one <i>is</i> good but One, <i>that is</i>, God.</p> <p>²⁰ "You know the commandments: 'Do not commit adultery,' 'Do not murder,' 'Do not steal,' 'Do not bear false witness,' 'Honor your father and your mother.'"</p> <p>²¹ And he said, "All these things I have kept from my youth."</p> <p>²² So when Jesus heard these things, He said to him, "You still lack one thing. Sell all that you have and distribute to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven; and come, follow Me."</p> <p>²³ But when he heard this, he became very sorrowful, for he was very rich.</p>
Command	<p>Eph 6:1-3 Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right.</p> <p>² "Honor your father and mother," which is the first commandment with promise:</p> <p>³ "that it may be well with you and you may live long on the earth."</p>
Command	<p>Ex 20:12 Honor your father and your mother, that your days may be long upon the land which the LORD your God is giving you.</p>
Command	<p>Lev 19:3 Every one of you shall revere his mother and his father, and keep My Sabbaths: I <i>am</i> the LORD your God. (<i>yare – yaw-ray – to fear, revere, be afraid</i>)</p>
Command	<p>Deut 5:16 Honor your father and your mother, as the LORD your God has commanded you, that your days may be long, and that it may be well with you in the land which the LORD your God is giving you.</p>
Command	<p>Mark 7:10 "For Moses said, 'Honor your father and your mother'; and, 'He who curses father or mother, let him be put to death.'</p>
Example	<p>Luk 2:51 Then He went down with them and came to Nazareth, and was subject to them, but His mother kept all these things in her heart.</p>
Example	<p>Gen 28:5-9 ⁵ So Isaac sent Jacob away, and he went to Padan Aram, to Laban the son of Bethuel the Syrian, the brother of Rebekah, the mother of Jacob and Esau.</p> <p>⁶ Esau saw that Isaac had blessed Jacob and sent him away to Padan Aram to take himself a wife from there, <i>and that</i> as he blessed him he gave him a charge, saying, "You shall not take a wife from the daughters of Canaan,"</p> <p>⁷ and that Jacob had obeyed his father and his mother and had gone to Padan Aram.</p> <p>⁸ Also Esau saw that the daughters of Canaan did not please his father Isaac.</p> <p>⁹ So Esau went to Ishmael and took Mahalath the daughter of Ishmael, Abraham's son, the sister of Nebajoth, to be his wife in addition to the wives he had.</p>
Example	<p>Josh 2:13 "and spare my father, my mother, my brothers, my sisters, and all that they have, and deliver our lives from death." ¹⁸ "unless, <i>when</i> we come into the land, you bind this line of scarlet cord in the window through which you let us down, and unless you bring your father, your mother, your brothers, and all your father's household to your own home. ²³ And the young men who had been spies went in and brought out Rahab, her father, her mother, her brothers, and all that she had. So they brought out all her relatives and left them outside the camp of Israel.</p>
Example	<p>1 Sam 22:3 Then David went from there to Mizpah of Moab; and he said to the king of Moab, "Please let my father and mother come here with you, till I know what God will do for me."</p>
Example	<p>2 Sam 19:37 "Please let your servant turn back again, that I may die in my own city, near the grave of my father and mother. But here is your servant Chimham; let him cross over with my lord</p>

	the king, and do for him what seems good to you." (Barzillai to David)
Example	1 Kings 19:20 And he left the oxen and ran after Elijah, and said, "Please let me kiss my father and my mother, and <i>then</i> I will follow you." And he said to him, "Go back again, for what have I done to you?"
Example	Esther 2:7 And <i>Mordecai</i> had brought up Hadassah, that <i>is</i> , Esther, his uncle's daughter, for she had neither father nor mother. The young woman <i>was</i> lovely and beautiful. When her father and mother died, Mordecai took her as his own daughter.
Example (Bad)	Judges 14:1-9 Now Samson went down to Timnah, and saw a woman in Timnah of the daughters of the Philistines. ² So he went up and told his father and mother, saying, "I have seen a woman in Timnah of the daughters of the Philistines; now therefore, get her for me as a wife." ³ Then his father and mother said to him, " <i>Is there</i> no woman among the daughters of your brethren, or among all my people, that you must go and get a wife from the uncircumcised Philistines?" And Samson said to his father, "Get her for me, for she pleases me well." ⁴ But his father and mother did not know that it was of the LORD-- that He was seeking an occasion to move against the Philistines. For at that time the Philistines had dominion over Israel. ⁵ So Samson went down to Timnah with his father and mother, and came to the vineyards of Timnah. Now <i>to his</i> surprise, a young lion <i>came</i> roaring against him. ⁶ And the Spirit of the LORD came mightily upon him, and he tore the lion apart as one would have torn apart a young goat, though <i>he had</i> nothing in his hand. But he did not tell his father or his mother what he had done. ⁷ Then he went down and talked with the woman; and she pleased Samson well. ⁸ After some time, when he returned to get her, he turned aside to see the carcass of the lion. And behold, a swarm of bees and honey <i>were</i> in the carcass of the lion. ⁹ He took some of it in his hands and went along, eating. When he came to his father and mother, he gave <i>some</i> to them, and they also ate. But he did not tell them that he had taken the honey out of the carcass of the lion. (v. 14 also)
Example?	Gen 37:10 So he told <i>it</i> to his father and his brothers; and his father rebuked him and said to him, "What <i>is</i> this dream that you have dreamed? Shall your mother and I and your brothers indeed come to bow down to the earth before you?"
Extent	Psalms 27:10 When my father and my mother forsake me, Then the LORD will take care of me.
Extent	Pro 23:22 Listen to your father who begot you, And do not despise your mother when she is old.
In Death	Lev 21:1-3 And the LORD said to Moses, "Speak to the priests, the sons of Aaron, and say to them: None shall defile himself for the dead among his people, ² except for his relatives who are nearest to him: his mother, his father, his son, his daughter, and his brother; ³ also his virgin sister who is near to him, who has had no husband, for her he may defile himself.
In Death	Lev 21:10-11 ¹⁰ <i>He who is</i> the high priest among his brethren, on whose head the anointing oil was poured and who is consecrated to wear the garments, shall not uncover his head nor tear his clothes; ¹¹ nor shall he go near any dead body, nor defile himself for his father or his mother;
In Death	Num 6:7 He shall not make himself unclean even for his father or his mother, for his brother or his sister, when they die, because his separation to God <i>is</i> on his head. (Nazirite vow)
In Death	Ezek 44:25 "They shall not defile <i>themselves</i> by coming near a dead person. Only for father or mother, for son or daughter, for brother or unmarried sister may they defile themselves.
Kindness	Prov 19:26 He who mistreats <i>his</i> father <i>and</i> chases away <i>his</i> mother <i>is</i> a son who causes shame and brings reproach.
Kindness	Prov 28:24 Whoever robs his father or his mother, And says, " <i>It is</i> no transgression," The same <i>is</i> companion to a destroyer.
Kindness – Phys	Ex 21:15 And he who strikes his father or his mother shall surely be put to death.
Kindness – Verb	Ex 21:17 And he who curses his father or his mother shall surely be put to death.
Kindness – Verb	Lev 20:9 For everyone who curses his father or his mother shall surely be put to death. He has cursed his father or his mother. His blood <i>shall be</i> upon him.
Kindness – Verb	Prov 20:20 Whoever curses his father or his mother, His lamp will be put out in deep darkness.
Kindness – Verb	Prov 30:11 <i>There is</i> a generation <i>that</i> curses its father, And does not bless its mother.
Listen & Follow	Prov 1:8 My son, hear the instruction of your father, And do not forsake the law of your mother;
Listen & Follow	Prov 10:1 The Proverbs of Solomon: A wise son makes a glad father, But a foolish son <i>is</i> the grief of his mother.
Listen & Follow	Prov 15:20 A wise son makes a father glad, But a foolish man despises his mother.
Listen & Follow	Pro 23:22-26 ²² Listen to your father who begot you, And do not despise your mother when she is old. ²³ Buy the truth, and do not sell <i>it</i> , <i>Also</i> wisdom and instruction and understanding. ²⁴ The

	father of the righteous will greatly rejoice, And he who begets a wise <i>child</i> will delight in him. ²⁵ Let your father and your mother be glad, And let her who bore you rejoice. ²⁶ My son, give me your heart, And let your eyes observe my ways. (NKJ)
Moral Respect	Lev 18:7 The nakedness of your father or the nakedness of your mother you shall not uncover. She <i>is</i> your mother; you shall not uncover her nakedness.
Moral Respect	Lev 18:9 The nakedness of your sister, the daughter of your father, or the daughter of your mother, <i>whether</i> born at home or elsewhere, their nakedness you shall not uncover.
Moral Respect	Lev 20:11 The man who lies with his father's wife has uncovered his father's nakedness; both of them shall surely be put to death. Their blood <i>shall be</i> upon them. (<i>guilty of death because of dishonoring father over committing adultery, because the command is before that in the 10 Com</i>)
Moral Respect	Lev 21:9 The daughter of any priest, if she profanes herself by playing the harlot, she profanes her father. She shall be burned with fire.
Moral Respect	Deut 27:22 `Cursed <i>is</i> the one who lies with his sister, the daughter of his father or the daughter of his mother.' And all the people shall say, 'Amen!'
Obedience	Eph 6:1 Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right. Τὰ τέκνα, ὑπακούετε τοῖς γονεῦσιν ὑμῶν [ἐν κυρίῳ]· τοῦτο γάρ ἐστιν δίκαιον.
Obedience	Col 3:20 Children, obey your parents in all things, for this is well pleasing to the Lord. Τὰ τέκνα, ὑπακούετε τοῖς γονεῦσιν κατὰ πάντα, τοῦτο γάρ εὐάρεστόν ἐστιν ἐν κυρίῳ.
Obedience	Eph 6:1-3 Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right. ² "Honor your father and mother," which is the first commandment with promise: ³ "that it may be well with you and you may live long on the earth."
Obedience	Deut 21:18-21 ¹⁸ "If a man has a stubborn and rebellious son who will not obey the voice of his father or the voice of his mother, and <i>who</i> , when they have chastened him, will not heed them, ¹⁹ "then his father and his mother shall take hold of him and bring him out to the elders of his city, to the gate of his city. ²⁰ "And they shall say to the elders of his city, 'This son of ours is stubborn and rebellious; he will not obey our voice; he is a glutton and a drunkard.' ²¹ "Then all the men of his city shall stone him to death with stones; so you shall put away the evil from among you, and all Israel shall hear and fear.
Obedience	Deut 27:16 `Cursed <i>is</i> the one who treats his father or his mother with contempt.' And all the people shall say, 'Amen!' (1) <i>to disgrace, dishonour, be lightly esteemed, be dishonoured, be despised 1a</i>) (<i>Niphal</i>) <i>to be dishonoured, be despised, be lightly esteemed 1b</i>) (<i>Hiphil</i>) <i>to treat with contempt, dishonour, treat shamefully</i>)
Obedience	Deut 33:9 Who says of his father and mother, 'I have not seen them'; Nor did he acknowledge his brothers, Or know his own children; For they have observed Your word And kept Your covenant.
Obedience	Prov 30:17 The eye <i>that</i> mocks <i>his</i> father, And scorns obedience to <i>his</i> mother, The ravens of the valley will pick it out, And the young eagles will eat it.
Obedience	Ezek 22:7 In you they have made light of father and mother; in your midst they have oppressed the stranger; in you they have mistreated the fatherless and the widow. (<i>to be slight, be swift, be trifling, be of little account, be light</i>)
Obedience	Micah 7:6 For son dishonors father, Daughter rises against her mother, Daughter-in-law against her mother-in-law; A man's enemies <i>are</i> the men of his own household.
Parents' Failure	1 Kings 1:6 (And his father had not rebuked him at any time by saying, "Why have you done so?" He <i>was</i> also very good-looking. <i>His mother</i> had borne him after Absalom.)
Parents' Resp	Zech 13:3 "It shall come to pass <i>that</i> if anyone still prophesies, then his father and mother who begot him will say to him, 'You shall not live, because you have spoken lies in the name of the LORD.' And his father and mother who begot him shall thrust him through when he prophesies.
Parents' Resp	2 Cor 12:14 Now <i>for</i> the third time I am ready to come to you. And I will not be burdensome to you; for I do not seek yours, but you. For the children ought not to lay up for the parents, but the parents for the children. Ἴδού τρίτον τοῦτο ἐτοίμως ἔχω ἐλθεῖν πρὸς ὑμᾶς, καὶ οὐ καταναρκήσω· οὐ γὰρ ζητῶ τὰ ὑμῶν ἀλλὰ ὑμᾶς. οὐ γὰρ ὀφείλει τὰ τέκνα τοῖς γονεῦσιν θησαυρίζειν ἀλλὰ οἱ γονεῖς τοῖς τέκνοις.
Parents' Resp	Heb 11:23 By faith Moses, when he was born, was hidden three months by his parents, because they saw <i>he was</i> a beautiful child; and they were not afraid of the king's command. Πίστει Μωϋσῆς γεννηθεὶς ἐκρύβη τρίμηνον ὑπὸ τῶν πατέρων αὐτοῦ, διότι εἶδον ἀστεῖον τὸ παιδίον καὶ οὐκ ἐφοβήθησαν τὸ διάταγμα τοῦ βασιλέως.
Parents' Resp	Deut 22:13-19 ¹³ "If any man takes a wife, and goes in to her, and detests her, ¹⁴ "and charges her with shameful conduct, and brings a bad name on her, and says, 'I took this woman, and when I came to her I found she <i>was</i> not a virgin,'

	<p>¹⁵ "then the father and mother of the young woman shall take and bring out <i>the evidence</i> of the young woman's virginity to the elders of the city at the gate.</p> <p>¹⁶ "And the young woman's father shall say to the elders, 'I gave my daughter to this man as wife, and he detests her.</p> <p>¹⁷ 'Now he has charged her with shameful conduct, saying, "I found your daughter was not a virgin," and yet these <i>are the evidences</i> of my daughter's virginity.' And they shall spread the cloth before the elders of the city.</p> <p>¹⁸ "Then the elders of that city shall take that man and punish him;</p> <p>¹⁹ "and they shall fine him one hundred <i>shekels</i> of silver and give <i>them</i> to the father of the young woman, because he has brought a bad name on a virgin of Israel. And she shall be his wife; he cannot divorce her all his days.</p>
Parents' Resp	Mark 5:40 And they ridiculed Him. But when He had put them all outside, He took the father and the mother of the child, and those <i>who were</i> with Him, and entered where the child was lying.
Rejection Of	Rom 1:30 backbiters, haters of God, violent, proud, boasters, inventors of evil things, disobedient to parents, καταλάλους θεοστυγείς ὑβριστὰς ὑπερηφάνους ἀλαζόνας, ἐφευρετὰς κακῶν, γονεῦσιν ἀπειθεῖς,
Rejection Of	2 Tim 3:2 For men will be lovers of themselves, lovers of money, boasters, proud, blasphemers, disobedient to parents, unthankful, unholy, ἔσονται γὰρ οἱ ἄνθρωποι φίλαυτοι φιλάργυροι ἀλαζόνες ὑπερήφανοι βλάσφημοι, γονεῦσιν ἀπειθεῖς, ἀχάριστοι ἀνόσιοι
z	Gen 2:24 Therefore a man shall leave his father and mother and be joined to his wife, and they shall become one flesh.
z	Deut 21:10-13 ¹⁰ "When you go out to war against your enemies, and the LORD your God delivers them into your hand, and you take them captive, ¹¹ "and you see among the captives a beautiful woman, and desire her and would take her for your wife, ¹² "then you shall bring her home to your house, and she shall shave her head and trim her nails. ¹³ "She shall put off the clothes of her captivity, remain in your house, and mourn her father and her mother a full month; after that you may go in to her and be her husband, and she shall be your wife. (<i>Even in conquering, honor of parents must not be overlooked!</i>)
z	Ruth 2:11 And Boaz answered and said to her, "It has been fully reported to me, all that you have done for your mother-in-law since the death of your husband, and <i>how</i> you have left your father and your mother and the land of your birth, and have come to a people whom you did not know before.
z	1 Kings 22:52 He did evil in the sight of the LORD, and walked in the way of his father and in the way of his mother and in the way of Jeroboam the son of Nebat, who had made Israel sin;
z	2 Kings 3:2 And he did evil in the sight of the LORD, but not like his father and mother; for he put away the <i>sacred</i> pillar of Baal that his father had made.
z	2 Kings 3:13 Then Elisha said to the king of Israel, "What have I to do with you? Go to the prophets of your father and the prophets of your mother." But the king of Israel said to him, "No, for the LORD has called these three kings <i>together</i> to deliver them into the hand of Moab."
z	2 Kings 4:19 And he said to his father, "My head, my head!" So he said to a servant, "Carry him to his mother."
z	Matt 10:35 "For I have come to set a man against his father, a daughter against her mother, and a daughter-in-law against her mother-in-law";
z	Matt 10:37 "He who loves father or mother more than Me is not worthy of Me. And he who loves son or daughter more than Me is not worthy of Me.
z	Matt 12:50 "For whoever does the will of My Father in heaven is My brother and sister and mother."

(Job 17:14 If I say to corruption, 'You are my father,' And to the worm, 'You are my mother and my sister,'
(Jeremiah 16:7 "Nor shall *men* break *bread* in mourning for them, to comfort them for the dead; nor shall *men* give them the cup of consolation to drink for their father or their mother.
Ezek 16:3 "and say, 'Thus says the Lord GOD to Jerusalem: "Your birth and your nativity are from the land of Canaan; your father was an Amorite and your mother a Hittite.
