Discipline #5: Committed Gathering

Because I am part of THE Body, I faithfully gather with a local body in accordance with God's design to be grown and help the body to grow.

Heb 10:24-25 And let us consider one another in order to stir up love and good works, ²⁵ not <u>forsaking</u> the ASSEMBLING of <u>ourselves</u> together, as *is* the manner of some, but <u>exhorting</u> one another, and so much the more as you see the Day approaching.

When NOT to Gather

Matthew 18:15-20

¹⁵ "Moreover if your brother sins against you, go and tell him his fault between you and him alone. If he hears you, you have gained your brother.

¹⁶ "But if he will not hear, take with you one or two more, that by the mouth of two or three witnesses every word may be established.'

¹⁷ "And if he refuses to hear them, tell *it* to the church. But if he refuses even to hear the church, let him be to you like a heathen and a tax collector.

¹⁸ "Assuredly, I say to you, whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven.

¹⁹ "Again I say to you that if two of you agree on earth concerning anything that they ask, it will be done for them by My Father in heaven.

²⁰ "For where two or three are gathered together in My name, I am there in the midst of them."

Matthew 9:10-11 ¹⁰ Now it happened, as Jesus sat at the table in the house, *that* behold, many tax collectors and sinners came and sat down with Him and His disciples. ¹¹ And when the Pharisees saw *it*, they said to His disciples, "Why does your Teacher eat with tax collectors and sinners?" ¹² When Jesus heard *that*, He said to them, "Those who are well have no need of a physician, but those who are sick.

1 Corinthians 5:1

- It is actually reported that there is sexual immorality among you, and such sexual immorality as is not even named among the Gentiles-- that a man has his father's wife!
- And you are puffed up, and have not rather mourned, that he who has done this deed might be taken away from among you.
- For I indeed, as absent in body but present in spirit, have already judged (as though I were present) him who has so done this deed.
- ⁴ In the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, when you are gathered together, along with my spirit, with the power of our Lord Jesus Christ,
- ⁵ deliver such a one to Satan for the destruction of the flesh, that his spirit may be saved in the day of the Lord Jesus.
- ⁶ Your glorying is not good. Do you not know that a little leaven leavens the whole lump?
- ⁷ Therefore purge out the old leaven, that you may be a new lump, since you truly are unleavened. For indeed Christ, our Passover, was sacrificed for us.
- ⁸ Therefore let us keep the feast, not with old leaven, nor with the leaven of malice and wickedness, but with the unleavened bread of sincerity and truth.
- ⁹ I wrote to you in my epistle not to keep company with sexually immoral people.
- ¹⁰ Yet I certainly did not mean with the sexually immoral people of this world, or with the covetous, or extortioners, or idolaters, since then you would need to go out of the world.
- 11 But now I have written to you not to keep company with anyone named a brother, who is sexually immoral, or covetous, or an idolater, or a reviler, or a drunkard, or an extortioner-- not even to eat with such a person.
- ¹² For what *have* I *to do* with judging those also who are outside? Do you not judge those who are inside?
- ¹³ But those who are outside God judges. Therefore "put away from yourselves" the evil person."

RELATED PASSAGES

- **2 Thessalonians 3:10-15**¹⁰ For even when we were with you, we commanded you this: If anyone will not work, neither shall he eat.
- ¹¹ For we hear that there are some who walk among you in a disorderly manner, not working at all, but are busybodies.
- ¹² Now those who are such we command and exhort through our Lord Jesus Christ that they work in quietness and eat their own bread.
- ¹³ But as for you, brethren, do not grow weary in doing good.
- ¹⁴ And if anyone does not obey our word in this epistle, note that person and do not keep company with him, that he may be ashamed.
- ¹⁵ Yet do not count *him* as an enemy, but admonish *him* as a brother.

Blessed is the man Who walks not in the counsel of the ungodly, Nor stands in the path of sinners, Nor sits in the seat of the scornful;

- **2 Corinthians 6:14—7:1**14 Do not be unequally yoked together with unbelievers. For what fellowship has righteousness with lawlessness? And what communion has light with darkness?
- And what accord has Christ with Belial? Or what part has a believer with an unbeliever?
- ¹⁶ And what agreement has the temple of God with idols? For you are the temple of the living God. As God has said: "I will dwell in them And walk among them. I will be their God, And they shall be My people."
- ¹⁷ Therefore "Come out from among them And be separate, says the Lord. Do not touch what is unclean, And I will receive vou."
- 18 "I will be a Father to you, And you shall be My sons and daughters, Says the LORD Almighty."
- 7:1 Therefore, having these promises, beloved, let us cleanse ourselves from all filthiness of the flesh and spirit, perfecting holiness in the fear of God.
