- 6. The Promise of God's Recognition and Reward (Heb 6:10-12; 1 Cor 15:58)

Follow the ... Server: Helping Those Who Help

The DECIDER: "themselves" (the household of Stephanus)
The DIRECTION: "to the ministry of the saints"

The DIRECTIVE: "submit yourselves to such, and to everyone

Liberty: Free to Serve

Galatians 5:13 For you, brethren, have been called to liberty; only do not [use] liberty as an opportunity for the flesh, but through love serve one another.

FREEDOM # FREE TO DO WHAT I WANT":

- 1. Liberty = Freedom to <u>Serve</u> (13)
 - Our Calling → Freedom from the law and from lust
 - Our Cause → Not serving <u>self</u> but serving <u>saints</u>
- 2. Law = Love Your Neighbor as Yourself (14)
- 3. Lust = Following Your <u>Impulses</u> & <u>Feelings</u> (15)

SPIRIT VS. FLESH:

- 4. Two Choices = Spirit-living Defeats Lust-living (16)
- 5. Two Forces (17) The Spirit Against the Flesh
- 6. Two Worlds Under the Law / Free from the Law (18)
