1 Cor 16:15-16 I urge you, brethren-- you know the household of Stephanas, that it is the firstfruits of Achaia, and *that* they have devoted themselves to the ministry of the saints--16 that you also submit to such, and to everyone who works and labors with *us.* (cf. 1 Thes 5:12-13; 2 Tim 1:16-18; Rom 16:1; Eph 6:21; Col 1:7; 1 Tim 4:6)

The DECISION:" **devoted**"

The DECIDER: "themselves" (the household of Stephanus)

The DIRECTION: "to the ministry of the saints"

The DIRECTIVE: "submit yourselves to such, and to everyone who works and

labors with [us]."

Liberty: Free to Serve

Galatians 5:13 For you, brethren, have been called to liberty; only do not [use] liberty as an opportunity for the flesh, but through love serve one another.

Freedom ≠ Free To Do What I Want":

- 1. Liberty = Freedom to Serve (13)
 - Our Calling → Freedom from the law and from lust
 - Our Cause → Not serving self but serving saints
- 2. Law = Love Your Neighbor as Yourself (14)
- 3. Lust = Following Your Impulses & Feelings (15)

Spirit Vs. Flesh:

- 4. Two Choices = Spirit-living Defeats Lust-living (16)
- 5. Two Forces (17) The Spirit Against the Flesh

1 Thes 1:9 For they themselves declare concerning us what manner of entry we had to you, and how you turned to God from idols to serve the living and true God, (cf. Titus 3:1-8)

Gifted to Serve

An **enhanced ability**, given by the Holy Spirit by His divine choice to each and every believer, enabling one to perform a responsibility more perfectly for the benefit of other believers and for the ultimate purpose of building up the body of Christ.

Rewarded for Serving

1. God Will Reward Serving as Being to Him Directly

Matt 25:31-46 ³¹ "When the Son of Man comes in His glory ..., then He will sit on the throne of His glory.³² "All the nations will be gathered before Him, and He will separate them one from another, as a shepherd divides *his* sheep from the goats. ³³ "And He will set the sheep on His right hand, but the goats on the left. ³⁴ "Then the King will say to those on His right hand, 'Come, you blessed of My Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world: ³⁵ 'for I was hungry and you gave Me food; I was thirsty and you gave Me drink; I was a stranger and you took Me in; ³⁶ 'I was naked and you clothed Me; I was sick and you visited Me; I was in prison and you came to Me.' ³⁷ "Then the righteous will answer Him, saying, 'Lord, when did we see You hungry and feed *You*, or thirsty and give *You* drink? ³⁸ 'When did we see You a stranger and take *You* in, or naked and clothe *You*? ³⁹ 'Or when did we see You sick, or in prison, and come to You?' ⁴⁰ "And the King will answer and say to them, 'Assuredly, I say to you, inasmuch as you did *it* to one of the least of these My brethren, you did *it* to Me.' ⁴¹ "Then He will also say to those on the left hand...

Col 3:23-24 ²³ And whatever you do, do it heartily, as to the Lord and not to men, ²⁴ knowing that from the Lord you will receive the reward of the inheritance; for you serve the Lord Christ.

2. God Will Reward Us for Serving Our Enemies

Matt 5:44-48 ⁴⁴ "But I say to you, love your enemies, bless those who curse you, do good to those who hate you, and pray for those who spitefully use you and persecute you, ⁴⁵ "that you may be sons of your Father in heaven; for He makes His sun rise on the evil and on the good, and sends rain on the just and on the unjust. ⁴⁶ "For if you love those who love you, what reward have you? Do not even the tax collectors do the same? ⁴⁷ "And if you greet your brethren only, what do you do more *than others*? Do not even the tax collectors do so? ⁴⁸ "Therefore you shall be perfect, just as your Father in heaven is perfect.

3. God Will Reward Us Openly for Serving Quietly

Matt 6:3-4 ³ "But when you do a charitable deed, do not let your left hand know what your right hand is doing, ⁴ "that your charitable deed may be in secret; and your Father who sees in secret will Himself reward you openly.

4. God Will Reward Us in Proportion to Our Ability and Circumstance

Matt 10:41-42 ⁴¹ "He who receives a prophet in the name of a prophet shall receive a prophet's reward. And he who receives a righteous man in the name of a righteous man shall receive a righteous man's reward. ⁴² "And whoever gives one of these little ones only a cup of cold *water* in the name of a disciple, assuredly, I say to you, he shall by no means lose his reward."

5. God Will Reward Us When He Returns

Matt 16:24-27 ²⁴ Then Jesus said to His disciples, "If anyone desires to come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross, and follow Me. ²⁵ "For whoever desires to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for My sake will find it. ²⁶ "For what profit is it to a man if he gains the whole world, and loses his own soul? Or what will a man give in exchange for his soul? ²⁷ "For the Son of Man will come in the glory of His Father with His angels, and then He will reward each according to his works.

Rev 22:12 "And behold, I am coming quickly, and My reward *is* with Me, to give to every one according to his work.
