Communion Means THAT???

¹⁹ And He took bread, gave thanks and broke *it*, and gave *it* to them, saying, "This is My body which is given for you; do this in remembrance of Me." ²⁰ Likewise He also *took* the cup after supper, saying, "This cup *is* the new covenant in My blood, which is shed for you. (Luke 22:19-20)

²³ For I received from the Lord that which I also delivered to you: that the Lord Jesus on the *same* night in which He was betrayed took bread; ²⁴ and when He had given thanks, He broke *it* and said, "Take, eat; this is My body which is broken for you; do this in remembrance of Me." ²⁵ In the same manner *He* also *took* the cup after supper, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in My blood. This do, as often as you drink *it*, in remembrance of Me." ²⁶ For as often as you eat this bread and drink this cup, you proclaim the Lord's death till He comes. (1 Cor 11:23-26)

¹⁷ For we, *though* many, are one bread *and* one body; for we all partake of that one bread. (1 Cor 10:17)

WHY Did Jesus Tell Us to Do Communion?:

• To Remind Us of Very Important Things

HOW Did Jesus Tell Us to Do Communion?:

Jesus Used Bread as a Picture to Remind Us:

- 1. That He gave His body to die for us so we could be saved.
- 2. That when we are saved, we are part of His one body.
- 3. That since we are part of His body, we should <u>live</u> like Him.

Jesus Used <u>Juice</u> as a Picture to Remind Us:

- 1. That He paid a very high price to pay for us.
- 2. That He <u>purchased</u> many good things (benefits) for us.

Jesus Used **Both** of These to Remind Us:

- 1. Of His <u>death</u> (& resurrection)
- 2. Of His return (He's coming back!)
