THE BREAD – 2 Key Thoughts

- 1. Salvation
 - Jesus' sacrificial payment ("my body")
 - Jesus' substitutionary payment ("for you")
 - Jesus' propitiating payment (1 John 2:2; lamb of God)
- 2. Connection ("one body")
 - "guilty of the body..." (27)
 - "not discerning the Lord's body" (29)
 - "For we, though many, are one bread and one body; for we all partake of that one bread." (1 Cor. 10:17)
 - We are to see ourselves as one body, committed to one another and functioning as Christ's body with His sacrificial care towards one another.
 - **■** Wait for one another (33)
 - Prepare for one another (34)
 - Die for one another (1 John 3:16)

THE CUP — 1 Key Thought Provision - "this cup is the New Testament in (by) My blood" - Jesus' death activated the covenant - Jesus' death provides the blessings of the covenant (now and future)
