Jesus Uses One Reminder to Create a New Reminder

The Passover having been prepared, Jesus assembles in the prearranged upper room with His disciples. Jesus uses this event to establish key reminders for His disciples.

In today's study, our goal is not to explain the full meaning of communion, but to look at its creation and its transition from Passover the night Jesus was betrayed.

Parallel Passages: Matt 26:20-30 | Mark 14:17-26 | Luke 22:14-23 | John 13:1-38

A Suggested Timeline (33 AD)

(Passages are written to present WHAT happened, but not always in order.)

April 1 (Wednesday):

- Betrayal plot finalized → Judas & priests (Mt 26:1-5,14-16; Mk 14:1-2,10-11; Lk 22:1-6)
- Jesus anointed 2nd time (Mt 26:6-13; Mk 14:3-9; John 12:1-11)
- Jesus directs prep for Passover (Mt 26:17-19; Mk 14:12-16; Lk 22:7-13; Jn 13:1)

April 2 (Thursday):

- Jesus & the 12 gather for Passover (Mt 26:20; Mk 14:17; Lk 22:14-16)
- Jesus washes the feet of the 12 (John 13:2-17)
- Jesus shares the first cup with the 12 (Lk 22:15-18)
- Jesus reveals one will betray Him (Mt 22:21-24; Mk 14:18-21; Lk 21-23; Jn 13:18-26)
- Judas asks if it is he, and Jesus confirms that he is the betrayer (Mt 22:25)
- Satan enters Judas; Judas leaves to betray Jesus (Jn 13:27-31)

- 3. Jesus creates a new reminder which looks at His body & blood sacrifice.
- 4. Jesus left His apostles with a positive practice the night of His betrayal.
- 5. Jesus commands us to be doing this to remember Him until His kingdom.
