<p><sup>26</sup> And as they were eating, Jesus took <b>bread</b>, blessed and broke <i>it</i>, and gave <i>it</i> to the disciples and said, "<u>Take, eat</u>; this is <b>MY BODY</b>."</p>	<p><sup>22</sup> And as they were eating, Jesus took <b>bread</b>, blessed and broke <i>it</i>, and gave <i>it</i> to them and said, "<u>Take, eat</u>; this is <b>MY BODY</b>."</p>	<p><sup>19</sup> And He took <b>bread</b>, gave thanks and broke <i>it</i>, and gave <i>it</i> to them, saying, "This is <b>MY BODY</b> which is given for you; <u>do</u> this in remembrance of Me."</p>	<p><sup>23b</sup> on the <i>same</i> night in which He was betrayed took <b>bread</b>; <sup>24</sup> and when He had given thanks, He broke <i>it</i> and said, "<u>Take, eat</u>; this is <b>MY BODY</b> which is [broken] for you; do this in remembrance of Me."</p>
<p><sup>27</sup> Then He took the <b>cup</b>, and gave thanks, and gave <i>it</i> to them, saying, "<u>Drink</u> from it, all of you. <sup>28</sup> "For this is <b>MY BLOOD</b> of the new covenant, which is shed for many for the remission of sins. <sup>29</sup> "But I say to you, I will not drink of this fruit of the vine from now on until that day when I drink it new with you in My Father's kingdom."</p>	<p><sup>23</sup> Then He took the <b>cup</b>, and when He had given thanks He gave <i>it</i> to them, and they all drank from it. <sup>24</sup> And He said to them, "This is <b>MY BLOOD</b> of the new covenant, which is shed for many. <sup>25</sup> "Assuredly, I say to you, I will no longer drink of the fruit of the vine until that day when I drink it new in the kingdom of God."</p>	<p><sup>20</sup> Likewise He also <i>took</i> the <b>cup</b> after supper, saying, "This <b>cup</b> is the new covenant in <b>MY BLOOD</b>, which is shed for you."</p>	<p><sup>25</sup> In the same manner <i>He</i> also <i>took</i> the <b>cup</b> after supper, saying, "This <b>cup</b> is the new covenant in <b>MY BLOOD</b>. This <u>do</u>, as often as you drink <i>it</i>, in remembrance of Me."</p>

## Jesus Gives Key Elements of the New Reminder

1. The Event: \_\_\_\_\_
2. The Presenter: \_\_\_\_\_
3. The Symbols:
  - a. Bread ("loaf")
  - b. Cup (fruit of the [grape] vine – Mt 26:29; Mk 14:25)
4. The \_\_\_\_\_ of the Symbols:
  - a. For a \_\_\_\_\_:
    - Luke 22:19 "do this [bread] in remembrance of Me."
    - 1 Cor 11:24 "do this [bread] in remembrance of Me."
    - 1 Cor 11:25 "This [cup] do ... in remembrance of Me."
    - Heb 10:3 But in those [sacrifices there is] a reminder of sins every year. (cf. Heb 10:1-4)
  - b. Of specific \_\_\_\_\_:
5. The \_\_\_\_\_ of the Symbols:
  - a. The loaf is a reminder of Jesus' \_\_\_\_\_
    - An obvious symbol, not His real body (He was there!)
    - Luke adds: "which is given on behalf of you"
    - Paul adds: "which is [broken] on behalf of you"
  - b. The cup is a reminder of the \_\_\_\_\_ secured by Jesus' blood
    - Matthew: "This is my blood of the new covenant"
    - Mark: "This is my blood of the new covenant"
    - Luke: "This cup [is] the new covenant in/by my blood"
    - Paul: "This cup is the new covenant in/by my blood"
    - Again, an obvious symbol, not the covenant itself
6. The \_\_\_\_\_ References:
  - a. How \_\_\_\_\_?
    - 1 Cor 11:25 "As often as you do it..."
    - Possible minimum: Annually (like Passover)?
  - b. Until \_\_\_\_\_?
    - Jesus' reign in the kingdom? (Mt 26:29; Mk 14:25)
