peirasmos (π ειρασμός) – <u>temptation</u>, trial, test (21x in 20 verses) peiradzo (π ειράζω) – to <u>tempt</u>, to try, to test (38x in 34 verses)

LORD'S SAMPLE PRAYER

Mt 6:13 And do not lead us into <u>temptation</u>, But deliver us from the evil one. For Yours is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever. Amen.

Lk 11:4 And forgive us our sins, For we also forgive everyone who is indebted to us. And do not lead us into <u>temptation</u>, But deliver us from the evil one."

PRE-ARREST PRAYER

Matt 26:41 "Watch and pray, lest you enter into <u>temptation</u>. The spirit indeed *is* willing, but the flesh *is* weak." (cf. Mk 14:38)

Lk 22:40 When He came to the place, He said to them, "Pray that you may not enter into temptation."

Lk 22:46 Then He said to them, "Why do you sleep? Rise and pray, lest you enter into temptation."

PARABLE OF THE SEED (Seeds Which Fall on Rock)

Lk 8:13 "But the ones on the rock *are those* who, when they hear, receive the word with joy; and these have no root, who believe for a while and in time of temptation fall away.

ENTICEMENT TO SIN (by the DEVIL)

Matt 4:1 Then Jesus was led up by the Spirit into the wilderness <u>to be</u> <u>tempted</u> by the devil.

Mk 1:13 And He was there in the wilderness forty days, <u>tempted</u> by Satan, and was with the wild beasts; and the angels ministered to Him.

Matt 4:3 Now when the <u>tempter</u> came to Him, he said, "If You are the Son of God, command that these stones become bread."

Lk 4:2 <u>being tempted</u> for forty days by the devil. And in those days He ate nothing, and afterward, when they had ended, He was hungry.

Lk 4:13 Now when the devil had ended every <u>temptation</u>, he departed from Him until an opportune time.

1 Cor. 7:5 Do not deprive one another except with consent for a time, that you may give yourselves to fasting and prayer; and come together again so that Satan <u>does</u> not <u>tempt</u> you because of your lack of self-control.

1 Cor. 10:9 nor <u>let</u> us <u>tempt</u> Christ, as some of them also <u>tempted</u>, and were destroyed by serpents;

1 Thes 3:5 For this reason, when I could no longer endure it, I sent to know your faith, lest by some means the <u>tempter had tempted</u> you, and our labor might be in vain.

Heb 2:18 For in that He Himself has suffered, <u>being tempted</u>, He is able to aid those who <u>are tempted</u>.

ENTICEMENT TO SIN

Gal 6:1 Brethren, if a man is overtaken in any trespass, you who *are* spiritual restore such a one in a spirit of gentleness, considering yourself lest you also <u>be tempted</u>.

Jas 1:12(-13-14) Blessed *is* the man who endures <u>temptation</u>; for when he has been approved, he will receive the crown of life which the Lord has promised to those who love Him. ¹³ Let no one say when he <u>is tempted</u>, "<u>I am tempted</u> by God"; for God <u>cannot be tempted</u> by evil, nor does He Himself <u>tempt</u> anyone. ¹⁴ But each one <u>is tempted</u> when he is drawn away by his own desires and enticed.

1 Pet 1:6(-7) In this you greatly rejoice, though now for a little while, if need be, you have been grieved by various <u>trials</u>, ⁷ that the genuineness of your faith, *being* much more precious than gold that perishes, though it is tested by fire, may be found to praise, honor, and glory at the revelation of Jesus Christ,

1 Pet 4:12(-13-14) Beloved, do not think it strange concerning the fiery <u>trial</u> which is to try you, as though some strange thing happened to you; ¹³ but rejoice to the extent that you partake of Christ's sufferings, that when His glory is revealed, you may also be glad with exceeding joy. ¹⁴ If you are reproached for the name of Christ, blessed *are you*, for the Spirit of glory and of God rests upon you. On their part He is blasphemed, but on your part He is glorified.

2 Pet. 2:(7-) ⁷ and delivered righteous Lot, *who was* oppressed by the filthy conduct of the wicked ⁸ (for that righteous man, dwelling among them, tormented *his* righteous soul from day to day by seeing and hearing *their* lawless deeds)—⁹ *then* the Lord knows how to deliver the godly out of temptations and to reserve the unjust under punishment for the day of judgment,

Heb 4:15 For we do not have a High Priest who cannot sympathize with our weaknesses, but was in all *points* tempted as we are, yet without sin.

PARABLE OF THE SEED (Seeds Which Fall on Rock)

Lk 8:13 "But the ones on the rock *are those* who, when they hear, receive the word with joy; and these have no root, who believe for a while and in time of temptation fall away.

TEMPTATIONS FROM RICHES (and the DESIRE TO BE RICH)

1 Tim 6:9(-10) But those who desire to be rich fall into <u>temptation</u> and a snare, and *into* many foolish and harmful lusts which drown men in destruction and perdition. ¹⁰ For the love of money is a root of all *kinds of* evil, for which some have strayed from the faith in their greediness, and pierced themselves through with many sorrows.

PHYSICAL INFIRMITY

Gal 4:14 And my <u>trial</u> which was in my flesh you did not despise or reject, but you received me as an angel of God, *even* as Christ Jesus.

PHYSICAL TROUBLE FROM PEOPLE

Lk 22:28 "But you are those who have continued with Me in My trials.

Acts 20:19 "serving the Lord with all humility, with many tears and <u>trials</u> which happened to me by the plotting of the Jews;

VERBAL TESTING FROM PEOPLE

- Matt 16:1 Then the Pharisees and Sadducees came, and <u>testing</u> Him asked that He would show them a sign from heaven.
- Matt 19:3 The Pharisees also came to Him, <u>testing</u> Him, and saying to Him, "Is it lawful for a man to divorce his wife for *just* any reason?"
- Matt 22:18 But Jesus perceived their wickedness, and said, "Why do you test Me, *you* hypocrites?
- Matt 22:35 Then one of them, a lawyer, asked *Him a question*, <u>testing</u> Him, and saying,
- Mk 8:11 Then the Pharisees came out and began to dispute with Him, seeking from Him a sign from heaven, testing Him.
- Mk 10:2 The Pharisees came and asked Him, "Is it lawful for a man to divorce *his* wife?" testing Him.
- Mk 12:15 "Shall we pay, or shall we not pay?" But He, knowing their hypocrisy, said to them, "Why do you test Me? Bring Me a denarius that I may see it."
- Lk 11:16 Others, <u>testing</u> *Him*, sought from Him a sign from heaven.
- Jn 6:6 But this He said to test him, for He Himself knew what He would do.
- Jn 8:6 This they said, <u>testing</u> Him, that they might have *something* of which to accuse Him. But Jesus stooped down and wrote on the ground with *His* finger, as though He did not hear.

TESTING GOD (Sin)

- Acts 5:9 Then Peter said to her, "How is it that you have agreed together to test the Spirit of the Lord? Look, the feet of those who have buried your husband *are* at the door, and they will carry you out."
- Acts 15:10 "Now therefore, why <u>do</u> you <u>test</u> God by putting a yoke on the neck of the disciples which neither our fathers nor we were able to bear?
- Heb 3:8(-9) Do not harden your hearts as in the rebellion, In the day of <u>trial</u> in the wilderness, ⁹ Where your fathers <u>tested</u> Me, tried Me, And saw My works forty years.

A WORLDWIDE "HOUR OF TRIAL"

Rev 3:10 "Because you have kept My command to persevere, I also will keep you from the hour of <u>trial</u> which shall come upon the whole world, to test those who dwell on the earth.

TO EXAMINE

- 2 Cor. 13:5 <u>Examine</u> yourselves *as to* whether you are in the faith. Test yourselves. Do you not know yourselves, that Jesus Christ is in you?--unless indeed you are disqualified.
- Rev 2:2 "I know your works, your labor, your patience, and that you cannot bear those who are evil. And you <u>have tested</u> those who say they are apostles and are not, and have found them liars;
- Heb 11:17 By faith Abraham, when he <u>was tested</u>, offered up Isaac, and he who had received the promises offered up his only begotten *son*,

TO MAKE AN ATTEMPT

- Acts 9:26 And when Saul had come to Jerusalem, he <u>tried</u> to join the disciples; but they were all afraid of him, and did not believe that he was a disciple.
- Acts 16:7 After they had come to Mysia, <u>they tried</u> to go into Bithynia, but the Spirit did not permit them.
- Acts 24:6 "<u>He</u> even <u>tried</u> to profane the temple, and we seized him, and wanted to judge him according to our law.

ANYTHING THAT CHALLENGES YOUR BELIEF

- Jas 1:2(-3) My brethren, count it all joy when you fall into various <u>trials</u>, ³ knowing that the testing of your faith produces patience.
- Rev 2:10 "Do not fear any of those things which you are about to suffer. Indeed, the devil is about to throw *some* of you into prison, that you may <u>be tested</u>, and you will have tribulation ten days. Be faithful until death, and I will give you the crown of life.

GOD'S PROMISE IN TEMPTATIONS

1 Cor 10:13 No <u>temptation</u> has overtaken you except such as is common to man; but God *is* faithful, who will not allow you <u>to be tempted</u> beyond what you are able, but with the <u>temptation</u> will also make the way of escape, that you may be able to bear *it*.
