A Disciple Is a Learning Imitator of Jesus:

Matt 11:29 Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls.

Being a Disciple of Jesus Requires 3 Elements:

- 1. **Learning**: Putting God's truth in my head.
- 2. Living: Putting God's truth to practice.
- 3. **Leaving**: Prioritizing God's truth in my life.
