## How Do I Walk?

1.	Walk In
	<b>Ephesians 2:10</b> For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand <i>that we should walk in them</i> .
2.	Walk of Your
	<b>Ephesians 4:1</b> I, therefore, the prisoner of the Lord, beseech you to <i>walk worthy of the calling with which you were called</i> , with all lowliness and gentleness, with longsuffering, bearing with one another in love, endeavoring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.
3.	Walk In
	<b>Ephesians 5:1-4</b> Therefore be imitators of God as dear children. <sup>2</sup> And <i>walk in love</i> , as Christ also has loved us and given Himself for us, an offering and a sacrifice to God for a sweet-smelling aroma. <sup>3</sup> But fornication and all uncleanness or covetousness, let it not even be named among you, as is fitting for saints; <sup>4</sup> neither filthiness, nor foolish talking, nor coarse jesting, which are not fitting, but rather giving of thanks.
4.	Walk As Of
	<b>Ephesians 5:5-12</b> <sup>5</sup> For this you know, that no fornicator, unclean person, nor covetous man, who is an idolater, has any inheritance in the kingdom of Christ and God. <sup>6</sup> Let no one deceive you with empty words, for because of these things the wrath of God comes upon the sons of disobedience. <sup>7</sup> Therefore do not be partakers with them. <sup>8</sup> For you were once darkness, but now <i>you are</i> light in the Lord. <i>Walk as children of light</i> <sup>9</sup> (for the fruit of the Spirit <i>is</i> in all goodness, righteousness, and truth), <sup>10</sup> finding out what is acceptable to the Lord. <sup>11</sup> And have no fellowship with the unfruitful works of darkness, but rather expose <i>them.</i> <sup>12</sup> For it is shameful even to speak of those things which are done by them in secret.
5.	Walk and
	<b>Ephesians 5:15-17</b> <sup>15</sup> See then that you walk circumspectly, not as fools but as wise, <sup>16</sup> redeeming the time, because the days are evil. <sup>17</sup> Therefore do not be unwise, but understand what the will of the Lord [is].
