The Results of Evangelism

Acts 28:24 (28:16-31) - TWO POSSIBLE RESULTS (Categories)

Acts 28:24 And some were persuaded by the things which were spoken, and some disbelieved.

1. BELIEF

• some were persuaded by the things which were spoken, and

2. UNBELIEF

some disbelieved.

Acts 17:32-34 - THREE FUNCTIONAL RESULTS

1. <u>REJECTION</u> – Outright Disbelief (w/ Disinterest or Antagonism)
