### God's Design for Dads: A Father's Privileged Tasks

Fatherhood is one of the foundational responsibilities of God's creation.

The absence of a husband makes a woman a widow. The absence of a father makes a child an orphan. Either situation puts the widow or the orphan in a very vulnerable position. God speaks often of the care for widows and orphans.

When God commanded the first couple (Adam & Eve) to "be fruitful, multiply, fill the earth," it included the concept of fatherhood as the core responsibility of men throughout the ages. God's design for men to father children includes several God-assigned tasks for these fathers.

c) To My Children

Heb 12:5-11 And you have forgotten the exhortation which speaks to you as to sons: "My son, do not despise the chastening of the LORD, Nor be discouraged when you are rebuked by Him; <sup>6</sup> For whom the LORD loves He chastens, And scourges every son whom He receives." <sup>7</sup> If you endure chastening, God deals with you as with sons; for what son is there whom a father does not chasten? <sup>8</sup> But if you are without chastening, of which all have become partakers, then you are illegitimate and not sons. <sup>9</sup> Furthermore, we have had human fathers who corrected [us], and we paid [them] respect. Shall we not much more readily be in subjection to the Father of spirits and live? <sup>10</sup> For they indeed for a few days chastened [us] as seemed [best] to them, but He for [our] profit, that [we] may be partakers of His holiness. <sup>11</sup> Now no chastening seems to be joyful for the present, but painful; nevertheless, afterward it yields the peaceable fruit of righteousness to those who have been trained by it. (cf. Eph 6:4)
