## The Priority and Purpose of Fatherhood

### THE PRIORITY OF FATHERHOOD

1.	Fatherhood Is			

Gen. 1:27-28 So God created man in His *own* image; in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them. <sup>28</sup> Then God blessed them, and God said to them, "Be fruitful and multiply; fill the earth and subdue it; have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over every living thing that moves on the earth."

## 2. Fatherhood Is

Ps. 127:3-5 Behold, children *are* a heritage from the LORD, The fruit of the womb *is* a reward. <sup>4</sup> Like arrows in the hand of a warrior, So *are* the children of one's youth. <sup>5</sup> Happy *is* the man who has his quiver full of them; They shall not be ashamed, But shall speak with their enemies in the gate.

## 3. Fatherhood Is

Ps. 128:1-4 Blessed *is* every one who fears the LORD, Who walks in His ways. <sup>2</sup> When you eat the labor of your hands, You *shall be* happy, and *it shall be* well with you. <sup>3</sup> Your wife *shall be* like a fruitful vine In the very heart of your house, Your children like olive plants All around your table. <sup>4</sup> Behold, thus shall the man be blessed Who fears the LORD.

### 4. Fatherhood Is

1 Tim. 3:4-5 one who rules his own house well, having *his* children in submission with all reverence <sup>5</sup> (for if a man does not know how to rule his own house, how will he take care of the church of God?);

1 Tim. 3:12 Let deacons be the husbands of one wife, ruling *their* children and their own houses well.

# 1. To Provide for His Wife and Children

## a. Earning Adequate \_\_\_\_\_

Prov. 24:27 Prepare your outside work, Make it fit for yourself in the field; And afterward build your house.

1 Tim. 5:8 But if anyone does not provide for his own, and especially for those of his household, he has denied the faith and is worse than an unbeliever.

# b. Providing \_\_\_\_\_ & Shelter

Gen. 2:15 Then the LORD God took the man and put him in the garden of Eden to tend and keep it.

Deut. 10:18 He administers justice for the fatherless and the widow, and loves the stranger, giving him food and clothing.

## c. Caring for Their \_\_\_\_

Jn 4:47 When he heard that Jesus had come..., he went to Him and implored Him to come down and heal his son, for he was at the point of death.
