# 3 Key Steps

- 1. Identify Specific Commands
  - a. Has God spoken concerning this?
  - b. Has He said to do or not to do this?
- 2. Evaluate <u>General Principles</u>
  - a. Does something God has said relate to my situation or decision?
- 3. Exercise <u>Biblical</u> <u>Wisdom</u>
  - a. What does the Bible indicate is the wisest decision, direction or action?

### Principle #1: The Principle of PRIORITY

Matthew 6:33 But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you.

## Principle #2: The Principle of AUTHORITY

One of the most foundational concepts of a believer's growth is to learn the importance of authority and submission. Every relationship created by God has both authority and submission. Learning to submit is fundamental to our proper response to God, to having a godly marriage and raising godly children, to having a Biblically functioning congregation, and to our proper response to government and those without.

# New Testament "hupo" Words:

Several words are used in the NT for submission, and each has similar meanings with slightly different emphases:

- (1) *hupotasso* (ὑποτάσσω) means "to place under; to submit to"
- (2) *hupotage* (ὑποταγη) the noun form of hupotasso = "submission"
- (3) hupakouo (ὑπακούω) means "to listen under and be responsive to"
- (4) *hupakoe* (ὑπακοη) the noun form of hupakouo = "obedience"
- (5) hupeiko (ὑπείκω) means "to yield to; to give way to" (only in Heb 13:17, from eiko [εἴκω], to give place or to yield, used only in Gal 2:5 in a negative sense not to give in to those that demand keeping the Law)
