Not Advice / Circumstances / Consensus / Desires / Feelings

3 Key Steps

- 1. Identify <u>Specific Commands</u>
- 2. Evaluate General Principles
- 3. Exercise Biblical Wisdom

Principle #1: The Principle of PRIORITY

Matthew 6:33 But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you.

Am I seeking God's work and God's way in this?

Principle #2: The Principle of AUTHORITY

Romans 13:1-2 Let every soul be subject to the governing authorities. For there is no authority except from God, and the authorities that exist are appointed by God. Therefore whoever resists the authority resists the ordinance of God, and those who resist will bring judgment on themselves.

Am I regarding God-ordained authority?

1. Toward <u>God</u>

James 4:7 Therefore submit to God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you.

2. In the Family

Wives to Husbands

Col 3:18 Wives, submit to your own husbands, as is fitting in the Lord.

• Children to Parents

Eph 6:1 Children, **obey** your parents in the Lord, for this is right.

3. In the Church

To Spiritual Leaders

Heb 13:17a Obey those who rule over you, and be submissive, for they watch out for your souls, as those who must give account.

• To Older Leaders

1 Pet 5:5a Likewise you younger people, submit yourselves to *your* elders.

Believers Are To Submit To Those Devoted To Service

1 Cor 16:15-16 ¹⁵ I urge you, -- you know the household of Stephanas,... and that they have devoted themselves to the ministry of the saints – ¹⁶ that you also **submit** to such, and to everyone who works and labors with *us*.

Women In Silence

1 Tim 2:11 Let a woman learn in silence with all submission.

To One Another

Eph 5:21 submitting to one another in the fear of God.

To Government Leaders

1 Pet 2:13-14 Therefore **submit yourselves** to every ordinance of man for the Lord's sake, whether to the king as supreme, ¹⁴ or to governors, as to those who are sent by him for the punishment of evildoers and *for the* praise of those who do good.

Titus 2:9 *Exhort* bondservants to **be obedient** to their own masters, to be well pleasing in all *things*, not answering back,
