## What Does It Take to Change a Person? 3 Essentials of Sanctification

Moses called all Israel, and said to them: "Hear, O Israel, the statutes and judgments which I speak in your hearing today, that you may learn them and be careful to observe them. (Deuteronomy 5:1)

**3 Essentials of Sanctification:** Listen to the Word | Learn the Word | Live the Word Sanctification = Godly Change: Change your thinking. Change your talking. Change your relationships. Change your habits.

Essential #1: LISTEN to the WORD (Two Parts):

than godly edification which is in faith. <sup>5</sup> Now the purpose of the commandment is love from a pure heart, *from* a good conscience, and *from* sincere faith, <sup>6</sup> from which some, having strayed, have turned aside to idle talk, <sup>7</sup> desiring to be teachers of the law, understanding neither what they say nor the things which they affirm.
