## Serving the Lord Together with Excellence, Part 2 God Desires Excellence (1 Peter 4:10-11)

Serving the Lord Together with Excellence, #1: God Trains Me for Service (Eph 4:11-16)
God's Gifts – People (11) – Men appointed, gifted, & assigned by God
God's Goal – Purpose (12) – Equipping, serving, building
God's Guidance – Particulars (13-16)

<u>Not</u> "What do **I** or **we** want out of 'church'?" but "What does **God** want out of 'church'?" "that we might ALL attain..."

- <u>Unity</u> oneness doing things as one not individualistically determined or focused "unto the unity of the faith and of the knowledge of the Son of God"
- 2. <u>Totality</u> complete to the end, not half-way God wants to complete Northridge "to a perfect man."
- 3. <u>Maturity</u> positive measure to grow up fully as Christ "to the measure of the stature [or maturity] of the fullness of Christ;"
- 4. <u>Stability</u> negative measure not bounced or pushed infants "that we should no longer be children, tossed to and fro and carried about with every wind of doctrine, by the trickery of men, in the cunning craftiness of deceitful plotting,"

## (Process Restated)

"but, speaking the truth in love, may grow up in all things into Him who is the head—Christ"

- 5. <u>Entirety</u> every part learning its part and doing its part "from whom the whole body, joined and knit together by what every joint supplies, according to the effective working by which every part does its share,"
- 6. <u>Assembly</u> building up and increasing in size "causes growth of the body for the edifying of itself in love."

Luke 17:7-10 "And which of you, having a servant plowing or tending sheep, will say to him when he has come in from the field, 'Come at once and sit down to eat '? 8 "But will he not rather say to him, 'Prepare something for my supper, and gird yourself and serve me till I have eaten and drunk, and afterward you will eat and drink '? 9 "Does he thank that servant because he did the things that were commanded him? I think not. 10 "So likewise you, WHEN YOU HAVE DONE ALL THOSE THINGS WHICH YOU ARE COMMANDED, SAY, 'WE ARE UNPROFITABLE SERVANTS. WE HAVE DONE WHAT WAS OUR DUTY TO DO."

Rom 12:4-13 <sup>6</sup> Having then gifts differing according to the grace that is given to us, *let us use them*: if prophecy, *let us prophesy* in proportion to our faith; <sup>7</sup> or ministry, *let us use it* in *our* ministering; he who teaches, in teaching; <sup>8</sup> he who exhorts, in exhortation; he who gives, with liberality; he who leads, with diligence; he who shows mercy, with cheerfulness. <sup>9</sup> *Let* love *be* without hypocrisy. Abhor what is evil. Cling to what is good. <sup>10</sup> *Be* kindly affectionate to one another with brotherly love, in honor giving preference to one another; <sup>11</sup> NOT LAGGING IN DILIGENCE, FERVENT in spirit, serving the Lord; <sup>12</sup> rejoicing in hope, patient in tribulation, continuing steadfastly in prayer; <sup>13</sup> distributing to the needs of the saints, given to hospitality.

1 Cor 4:1-2 Let a man so consider us, AS SERVANTS OF CHRIST and STEWARDS OF THE MYSTERIES OF GOD. 2 Moreover it is REQUIRED in Stewards that one be found FAITHFUL.

**1 Cor 10:31** Therefore, whether you eat or drink, or whatever you do, <u>do all to the glory of God</u>.

**Eph 5:15-16** See then that you walk circumspectly, not as fools but as wise, <sup>16</sup> **REDEEMING THE TIME**, because the days are evil.

**Eph 6:5-8** Bondservants, be obedient to those who are your masters according to the flesh, with fear and trembling, in sincerity of heart, as to Christ;  $^6$  not with eyeservice, as menpleasers, but as bondservants of Christ, **DOING THE WILL OF GOD FROM THE HEART** (ἐχ ψυχῆς),  $^7$  with goodwill doing service, **AS TO THE LORD**, and not to men,  $^8$  knowing that whatever good anyone does, he will receive the same from the Lord, whether *he is* a slave or free.

**Phil 2:14-16** Do all things **WITHOUT COMPLAINING AND DISPUTING**, <sup>15</sup> that you may become blameless and harmless, children of God without fault in the midst of a crooked and perverse generation, among whom you shine as lights in the world, <sup>16</sup> **HOLDING FAST THE WORD OF LIFE**, so that I may rejoice in the day of Christ that I have not run in vain or labored in vain.

**Col 3:17** And <u>whatever you do</u> in word or deed, <u>do all in the name of the Lord Jesus</u>, giving thanks to God the Father through Him.

**Col 3:23-24** And whatever you do, **DO IT HEARTILY** (ἐ $\alpha$  ψυχῆς ἐργάζεσθε), **AS TO THE LORD AND NOT TO MEN**, <sup>24</sup> knowing that from the Lord you will receive the reward of the inheritance; for you serve the Lord Christ.

**2 Tim 2:15 BE DILIGENT** to present yourself approved to God, a worker who does not need to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth.

1 Pet 4:8-11 And above all things have FERVENT love for one another, for "love will cover a multitude of sins." <sup>9</sup> Be hospitable to one another WITHOUT GRUMBLING. <sup>10</sup> As each one has received a gift, minister it to one another, AS GOOD STEWARDS OF THE MANIFOLD GRACE OF GOD. <sup>11</sup> If anyone speaks, *let him speak* AS THE ORACLES OF GOD. If anyone ministers, *let him do it* AS WITH THE ABILITY WHICH GOD SUPPLIES, that in all things God may be glorified through Jesus Christ, to whom belong the glory and the dominion forever and ever. Amen.
