
Timeline of Truth – God Makes a Covenant with Noan (Genesis 8:20 – 9:17)

 3 "Every moving thing that lives shall be food for you. I have given you all things, even as the green herbs. 4 "But you shall not eat flesh with its life, that is, its blood. 	#2: Every Moving Animal Given for Food Prior to this, humans/animals had a vegetarian diet (Gen 1:29-30): And God said, "See, I have given you every herb [that] yields seed which [is] on the face of all the earth, and every tree whose fruit yields seed; to you it shall be for food. Also, to every beast of the earth, to every bird of the air, and to everything that creeps on the earth, in which [there is] life, [I have given] every green herb for food"; and it was so.

 8 Then God spoke to Noah and to his sons with him, saying: 9 "And as for Me, behold, I establish My covenant with you and with your descendants after you, 10 "and with every living creature that <i>is</i> with you: the birds, the cattle, and every beast of the earth with you, of all that go out of the ark, every beast of the earth. 11 "Thus I establish My covenant with you: Never again shall all flesh be cut off by the waters of the flood; never again shall there be a flood to destroy the earth." 12 And God said: "This <i>is</i> the sign of the covenant which I make between Me and you, and every living creature that <i>is</i> with you, for perpetual generations: 13 "I set My rainbow in the cloud, and it shall be for the sign of the covenant between Me and the earth. 14 "It shall be, when I bring a cloud over the earth, that the rainbow shall be seen in the cloud; 15 "and I will remember My covenant which <i>is</i> between Me and you and every living creature of all flesh; the waters shall never again become a flood to destroy all flesh. 6 "The rainbow shall be in the cloud, and I will look on it to remember the everlasting covenant between God and every living creature of all flesh that <i>is</i> on the earth." 17 And God said to Noah, "This <i>is</i> the sign of the covenant which I have established between Me and all flesh that <i>is</i> on the earth." 	God Expands on His Covenant with Noah Who the Covenant Is Between (9-10): God Noah & Noah's descendants Every living creature (birds, cattle, beast) What the Covenant Involves (11-17): Never will God cut off all flesh by a world-wide flood (11,15) The covenant is an everlasting covenant (16) The covenant is between God and every living creature of flesh that is on the earth (16-17) What God Gave as a Sign (12-17): Sign will be rainbow (12-13) Sign will remind God of His covenant (14-16) Sign is visible indication of God's covenant between Him and all flesh that is on the earth (17)
