
Timeline of Truth – Shem to Abram (Genesis 11:10-32)

OBSERVATIONS:

- Noah was the 10th generation on the earth. Abram (Abraham) was the 20th generation on the earth.
- The longevity of mankind after the flood greatly diminished (people lived much <u>less</u> longer).
 Something had drastically affected the length of life. (Impact of environmental changes following the flood?)
- 3. This is <u>real</u> history. Only 20 generations to Abram.
