## **Related NT Passages**

#### God of Abraham, Isaac, & Jacob (line of blessing & official connection)

- Matt 1:2 Abraham begot Isaac, Isaac begot Jacob, and Jacob begot Judah and his brothers.
- Mark 12:26 "But concerning the dead, that they rise, have you not read in the book of Moses, in the *burning* bush *passage*, how God spoke to him, saying, `I *am* the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob '? (cp. Matt 22:32; Luke 20:37; Acts 7:32)
- Luke 13:28 "There will be weeping and gnashing of teeth, when you see Abraham and Isaac and Jacob and all the prophets in the kingdom
  of God, and yourselves thrust out.

### Isaac the Son of Promise (not Ishmael)

- Rom 9:7 nor are they all children because they are the seed of Abraham; but, "In Isaac your seed shall be called."
- Gal 4:28 Now we, brethren, as Isaac was, are children of promise.
- Heb 11:18 of whom it was said, "In Isaac your seed shall be called,"
- Acts 7:8 "Then He gave him the covenant of circumcision; and so *Abraham* begot Isaac and circumcised him on the eighth day; and Isaac *begot* Jacob, and Jacob *begot* the twelve patriarchs.
- Luke 2:21 And when eight days were completed for the circumcision of the Child, His name was called JESUS, the name given by the angel before He was conceived in the womb.

#### Circumcision and Today

- Rom 2:25—3:19 (Explanation of the value of circumcision to Israel)
- Rom 4:11-12 And he received the sign of circumcision, a seal of the righteousness of the faith which [he had while still] uncircumcised, that he might be the father of all those who believe, though they are uncircumcised, that righteousness might be imputed to them also, and the father of circumcision to those who not only [are] of the circumcision, but who also walk in the steps of the faith which our father Abraham [had while still] uncircumcised.
- Gal 5:6 For in Christ Jesus neither circumcision nor uncircumcision avails anything, but faith working through love. (...but new creation 6:15)
- Gal 5:11 And I, brethren, if I still preach circumcision, why do I still suffer persecution? Then the offense of the cross has ceased.
- Phil 3:3 For we are the circumcision, who worship God in the Spirit, rejoice in Christ Jesus, and have no confidence in the flesh,
- Col 2:11 In Him you were also circumcised with the circumcision made without hands, by putting off the body of the sins of the flesh, by the circumcision of Christ.
