shut the door.		
<sup>11</sup> And they struck the men who were at the doorway of the house with blindness,		
both small and great, so that they became weary trying to find the door.

your daughters, and whomever you have in the city take <i>them</i> out of this place!		
13 "For we will destroy this place, because the outcry against them has grown great		
before the face of the LORD, and the LORD has sent us to destroy it."

and said, "Get up, get out of this place; for the LORD will destroy this city!" But to his		
sons-in-law he seemed to be joking.

for your life! Do not look behind you nor stay anywhere in the plain. Escape to the

## THE CITIES

- Gen 14:8 And the king of **Sodom**, the king of **Gomorrah**, the king of **Admah**, the king of **Zeboiim**, and the king of **Bela** (that *is*, **Zoar**) went out and joined together in battle in the Valley of Siddim
- Deut 29:23 `The whole land *is* brimstone, salt, and burning; it is not sown, nor does it bear, nor does any grass grow there, like the overthrow of **Sodom** and **Gomorrah**, **Admah**, and **Zeboim**, which the LORD overthrew in His anger and His wrath.'
- Luke 17:29 "but on the day that Lot went out of **Sodom** it rained fire and brimstone from heaven and destroyed *them* all.
- 2 Pet 2:6 and turning the cities of **Sodom** and **Gomorrah** into ashes, condemned *them* to destruction, making *them* an example to those who afterward would live ungodly;
- Jude 1:7 as Sodom and Gomorrah, and the cities around them in a similar manner to these, having given themselves over to sexual
  immorality and gone after strange flesh, are set forth as an example, suffering the vengeance of eternal fire.

## COMPARED TO OTHERS

- Matt 10:15 "Assuredly, I say to you, it will be more tolerable for the land of Sodom and Gomorrah in the day of judgment than for that city!
- Matt 11:23 "And you, Capernaum, who are exalted to heaven, will be brought down to Hades; for if the mighty works which were done in you had been done in **Sodom**, it would have remained until this day.
- Mark 6:11 "And whoever will not receive you nor hear you, when you depart from there, shake off the dust under your feet as a
  testimony against them. Assuredly, I say to you, it will be more tolerable for Sodom and Gomorrah in the day of judgment than for that
  city!"
- Luke 10:12 "But I say to you that it will be more tolerable in that Day for Sodom than for that city.

## LOT MENTIONED ELSEWHERE

- Deut 2:9 "Then the LORD said to me, `Do not harass Moab, nor contend with them in battle, for I will not give you *any* of their land *as* a possession, because I have given Ar to the descendants of **Lot** *as* a possession."
- Deut 2:19 `And *when* you come near the people of Ammon, do not harass them or meddle with them, for I will not give you *any* of the land of the people of Ammon *as* a possession, because I have given it to the descendants of **Lot** *as* a possession."
