And God said to him in a dream, "Yes, I know that you did this in the integrity of your heart. For I also withheld you from sinning against Me; therefore I did not let you touch her.	<ul> <li>God <u>Responds</u> to Abimelech's Plea</li> <li>I know you did this in innocence.</li> <li>I prevented you from sinning against me.</li> </ul>
7 "Now therefore, restore the man's wife; for he <i>is</i> a prophet, and he will pray for you and you shall live. But if you do not restore <i>her</i> , know that you shall surely die, you and all who <i>are</i> yours."	<ul> <li>God Commands Abimelech to Restore Sarah</li> <li>Restore her to Abraham</li> <li>As a prophet, he will pray for you.</li> <li>Refuse, and you and all yours will die.</li> </ul>

Abraham Answers Abimelech</li> <li>I thought the fear of God wasn't here</li> <li>I thought you will kill me because of Sarah</li> <li>She IS my sister (my half-sister)</li> <li>This was our pre-arranged plan (was he sharing the blame with Sarah?)</li> </ul>
<sup>14</sup> Then Abimelech took sheep, oxen, and male and female servants, and gave <i>them</i> to Abraham; and he restored Sarah his wife to him. <sup>15</sup> And Abimelech said, "See, my land <i>is</i> before you; dwell where it pleases you."	<ul> <li>11. Abimelech Responds in Three Ways:</li> <li>Gifts Abraham Wealth</li> <li>Restores Sarah to Abraham</li> <li>Gives Abraham an Open Welcome</li> </ul>
Then to Sarah he said, "Behold, I have given your brother a thousand pieces of silver; indeed this vindicates you before all who are with you and before everybody." Thus she was rebuked.	<ul> <li>12. Abimelech <u>Rebukes</u> Sarah</li> <li>I have made restoration to your BROTHER</li> <li>You are vindicated before all.</li> </ul>
17 So Abraham prayed to God; and God healed Abimelech, his wife, and his female servants. Then they bore <i>children</i> ; 18 for the LORD had closed up all the wombs of the house of Abimelech because of Sarah, Abraham's wife.	<ul> <li>13. Abraham Prays for Abimelech</li> <li>God healed Abimelech</li> <li>God healed Abimelech's wife &amp; female servants so they could bear children</li> <li>(Because God had closed up all the wombs of Abimelech's entire household!)</li> </ul>
