Abimelech Responds in Ways:</li> <li>Gifts Abraham Wealth</li> <li>Restores Sarah to Abraham</li> <li>Gives Abraham an Open Welcome</li> </ul>
Then to Sarah he said, "Behold, I have given your brother a thousand pieces of silver; indeed this vindicates you before all who are with you and before everybody." Thus she was rebuked.	Sarah     I have made restoration to your BROTHER     You are vindicated before all.
<ul> <li>17 So Abraham prayed to God; and God healed Abimelech, his wife, and his female servants. Then they bore <i>children</i>;</li> <li>18 for the LORD had closed up all the wombs of the house of Abimelech because of Sarah, Abraham's wife.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>13. Abraham for Abimelech</li> <li>God healed Abimelech's wife &amp; female servants so they could bear children</li> <li>(Because God had closed up all the wombs of Abimelech's entire household!)</li> </ul>
