## **Key Lessons:**

- God caused Jacob to prosper greatly, in spite of Laban's attempts to keep that from happening.
   God protected Jacob from Laban throughout his time with Laban, and after he fled from Laban.
- 3. God prompted Jacob to leave for his home after 20 years with Laban.
